PREPARATION FOR THE PATH OF SEEKING KNOWLEDGE

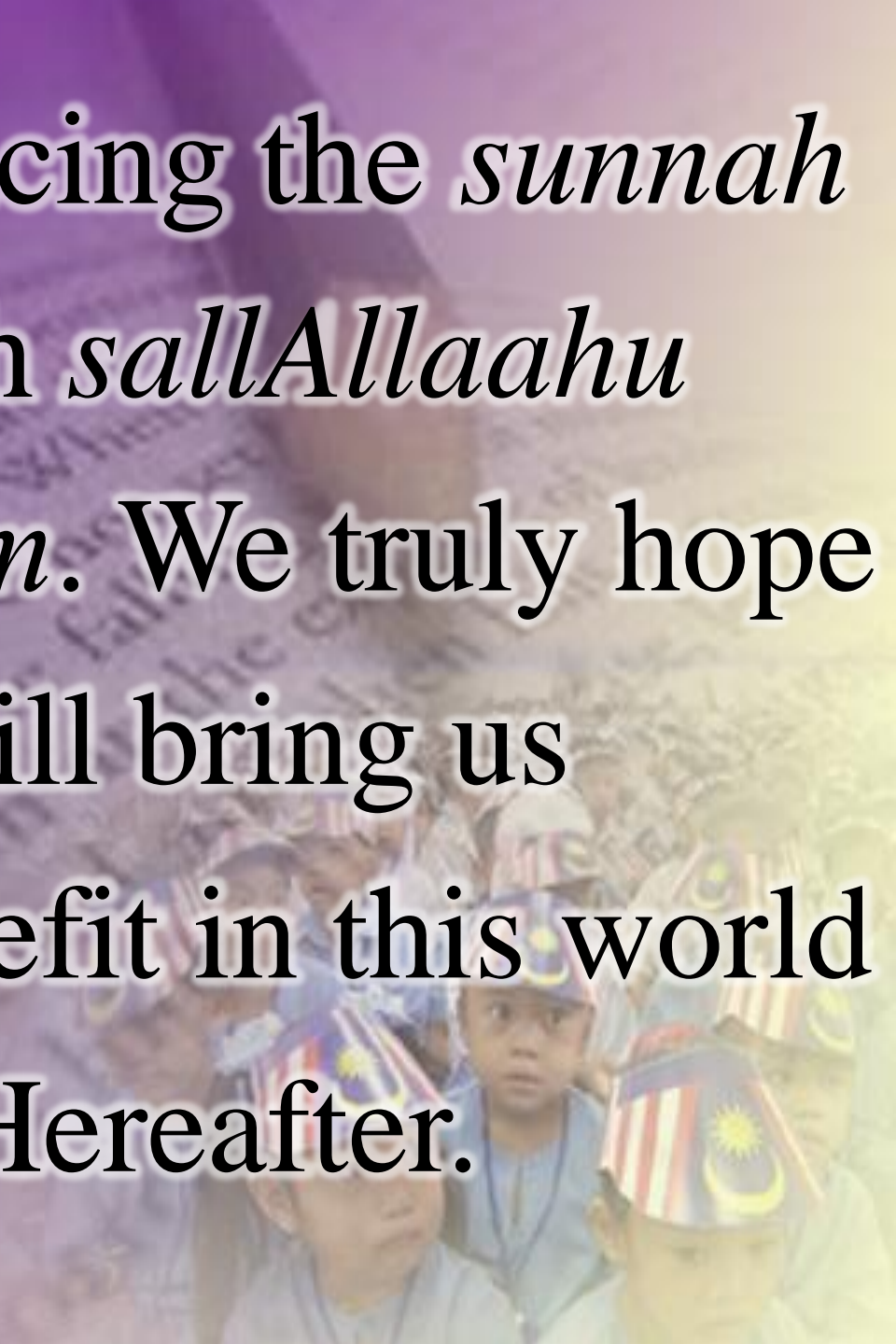


I implore upon all of us to

prohibitions.




Let us increase our

times.



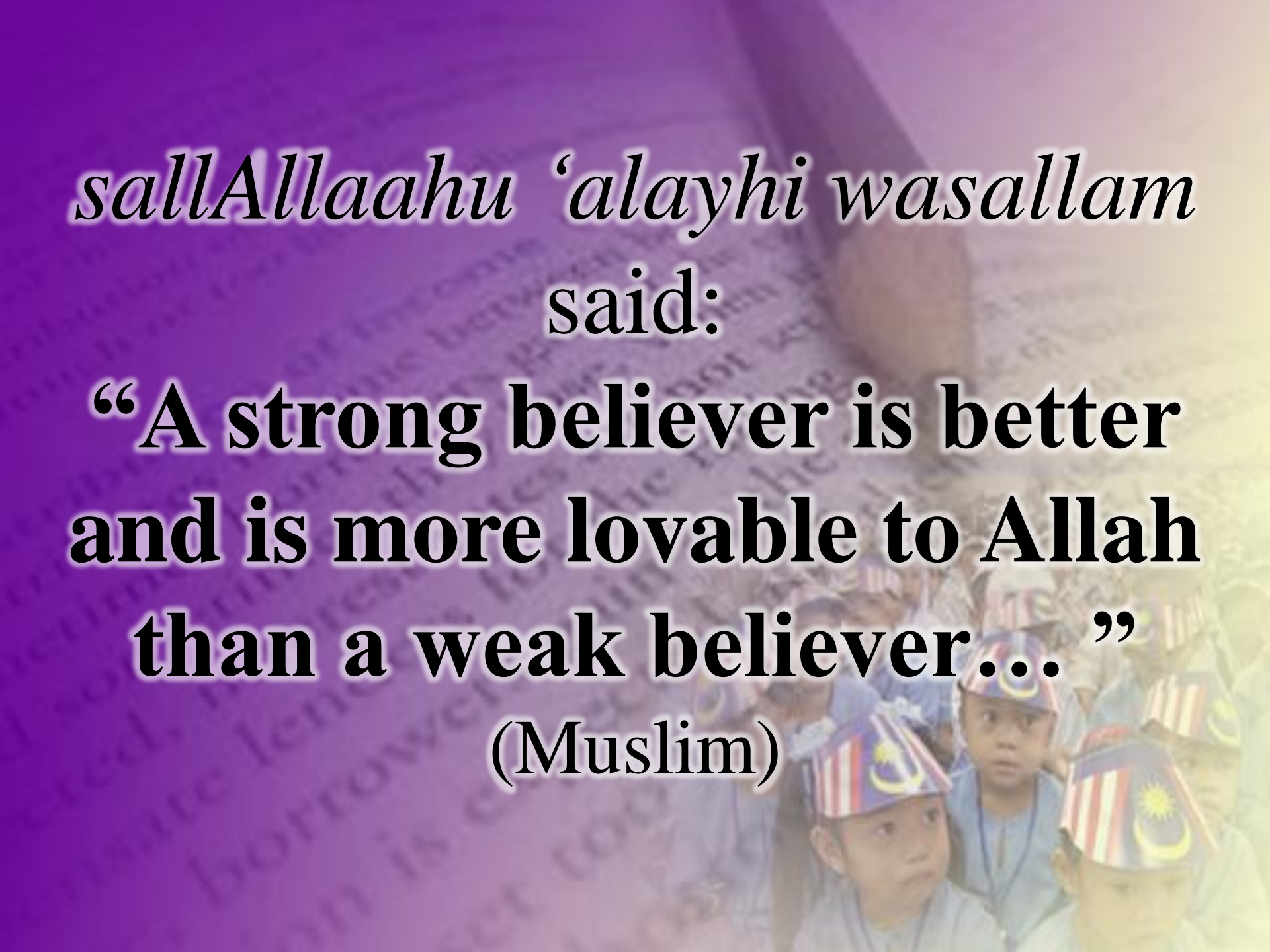

saheeh)**



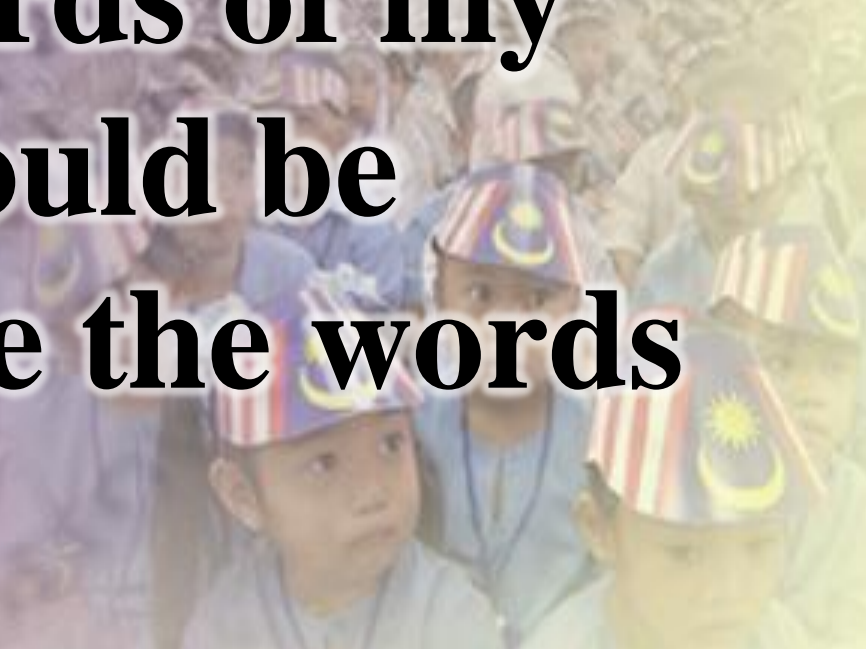


munkar and social vices that

Allah in the Hereafter. The


parents are to provide the much

1- The reward of Paradise

Narrated Abu Hurayrah

radhiyAllaahu 'anh that

Rasulullah *sallAllaahu 'alayhi
wasallam* said:

**“Whosoever follows a path to
seek knowledge therein, Allah
will make easy for him a path
to Paradise.”**

(Muslim)



2- Granted nobility throughout
life by Allah *Subhaanahu*
Wata'aala and His Messenger
sallAllaahu 'alayhi wasallam.
Abu ad-Dardaa' *radiyAllaahu*
'anh reported that Rasulullah
sallAllaahu 'alayhi wasallam
said:



“... The superiority of the learned man over the devout worshipper is like that of the full moon to the rest of the stars (i.e., in brightness) ...”

(Abu Dawood, at-Tirmidhi: *saheeh*)



It is evident that those seeking knowledge is not only elevated and benefited by the knowledge acquired, but also benefitted by others and the surrounding.



3- The angels and creations on earth will pray to Allah *Subhaanahu Wata'aala* seeking forgiveness for those seeking knowledge (part of previous *hadeeth* mentioned).



4- Those having knowledge have succeeded in ridding off ignorance from them, thus making it easier to abstain from vile and *munkar* acts.




Indeed, the soul that is pure and

out *jihaad*.

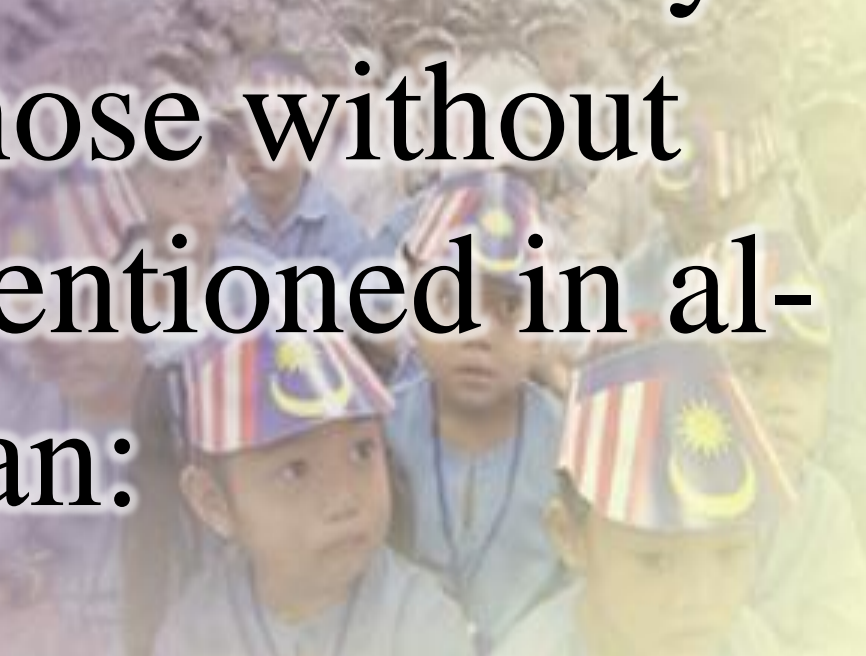

1- Allah *Subhaanahu Wata'aala* placed the people of knowledge at a high stature and nobility compared to those without knowledge, as mentioned in al-Qur'an:



**“ ... Allah will raise those who
have believed among you and
those who were given
knowledge, by degrees ...”**

(al-Mujaadilah 70:11)



2- The people of knowledge will be respected and looked up by the society, and they will be referred to for any arising matters. As Allah *Subhaanahu Wata'aala* mentions in al-Qur'an:



**“... so ask the people of the
message (*ahl adh-Dhikr*) if you
do not know.”** (al-Anbiyaa’
21:7)





Wata'aala.



On the contrary, being void of sound knowledge is akin to the blind person that will eventually become astray due to lack of guidance and not knowing the appropriate direction for the desired destination.

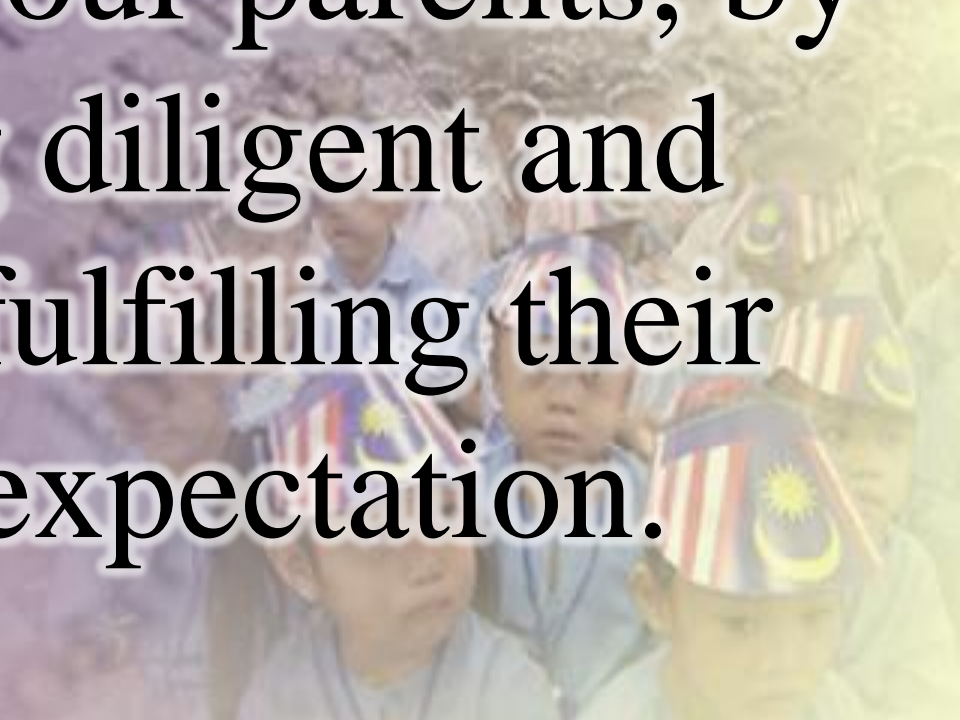

gain and reward from their offspring. Instead, they only yearn and desire to see their children succeed in wading through their lives in this world.



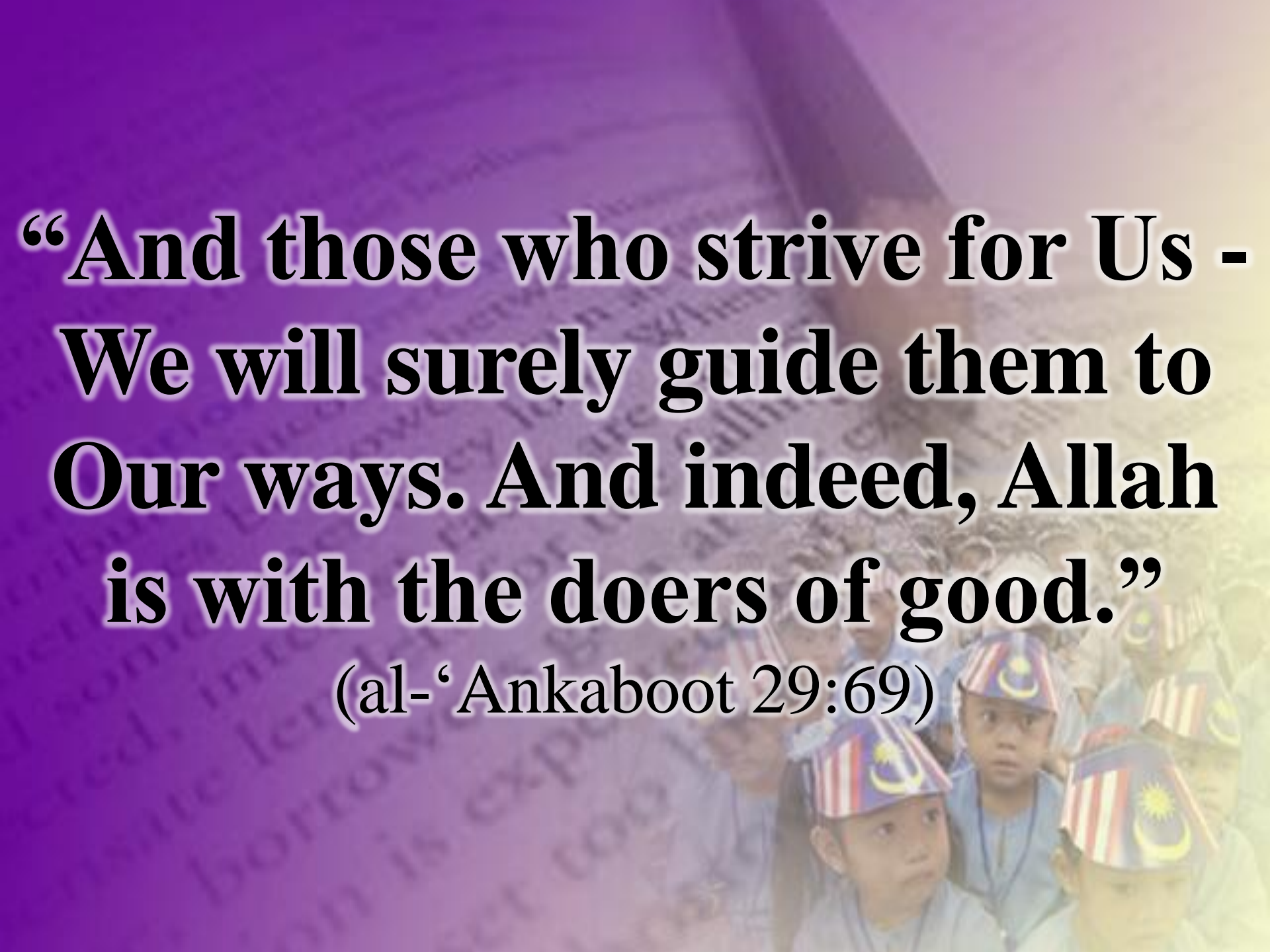




