I implore all of us to increase our taqwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala by performing all of His Commands and abstaining from all of His prohibitions.

Let us increase our dhikr (remembrance) of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aalaand increase our salawaat upon our beloved Messenger, Muhammad sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam,

and also strive our utmost in practicing all of his sunnah. Indeed, we truly hope that these efforts will bring us benefit in this world and the Hereafter.

Children are an amaanah that Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala has entrusted upon the parents to raise and groom in becoming beneficial individuals to mankind. They are like pure and clean white cloth that is to be decorated

and molded by the parents, according to their preference. Our progenies will later become our descendants and legacy that will inherit our very role as vicegerents in bringing prosperity to this earth

Therefore, as parents, we must strive our utmost to prepare and equip our offspring with taqwa. Shaykh Dr 'Abdullah Nasih Ulwan rahimahullah has outlined important points on the responsibilities of the

parents in the upbringing of their children unto becoming muttagoon, which is the tarbiyyah on imaan, akhlaaq, physical, mental, spiritual, and social aspects.

Children must be educated from their early age by inculcating values necessary in developing their imaan and taqwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala. With adequate upbringing on the tarbiyyah of imaan from an early age,

and equipped with sound evidence on tawheed and Oneness of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala, the children will not be easily swayed and susceptible to ideologies that can corrupt the 'aqeedah.

Among the ways to inculcate taqwa in the children are: 1- To train and make it a habit for them to always performing salaah once they are able to distinguish between right and wrong (mumayyiz), as mentioned in al-Qur'an:

"And establish prayer and give zakaah and bow with those who bow [in worship and obedience]."

(al-Baqarah 2:43)

2- Teach them to recite al-Qur'an and maintain its recitation on a constant basis 3- Providing them the tarbiyyah of akhlaaq and spirituality, as highly emphasized in Islam.

From an Islamic perspective, the teaching of noble akhlaaq is closely related with being cautious and safeguarding oneself from exceeding the limitations determined by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala. Hence, parents should take heavy

precaution in the tarbiyyah of virtuous akhlaaq by being watchful and preventing the children from bad habits and detestable characteristics. From among them are lying, stealing, vulgarity, swearing, and plagiarism.

At the same time, parents must give due emphasis on the spiritual values that leads to their taqwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala. These values must be inculcated from a very young age.

Among the values that can help shape this spirituality is bashfulness, humility (tawaddu'), dutiful to parents, teachers, and elders, and also not having pride (kibr) and ostentation (riyaa').

Without these values, their soul becomes empty and vulnerable to external negative elements that will lead them to become heartless and deviated from authentic Islamic teachings.

4- Parents are responsible to ensure that their children are in good physical condition. Being physically healthy is an important external factor that can help nurture the process of developing the 'aqeedah

and akhlaaq of the muttaqoon within them. This is in line with the message of Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam that was recorded in a hadeeth from Abu Hurayrah radiyAllaahu 'anh, which he sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam stated:

"A strong believer is better and is more lovable to Allah than a weak believer ... "

(Muslim)

The important matter that needs to be taken seriously by the parents for the physical wellbeing of their children is to provide food and drink that are halaal and nutritious, avoiding bad habits and negative activities that are detrimental

to themselves. The children must be well-informed of the danger of smoking, intoxicants, drug abuse, and other matters that are harmful to their health. They should be well-aware of the gravity of acts of disobedience such as

free mixing between genders, fornication, and many others, which can destroy the quality of their lives, on top of incurring the wrath of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala.

5- To teach our children aspects and intricacies of the social sphere and community living. These aspects must be embraced in their lives for as human being, they cannot run away and escape from their responsibility to the community which heavily

emphasize on brotherhood. Islam puts heavy importance on brotherhood and relationship amongst mankind living within a society. Indeed, the Muslim is not deemed as having imaan for as long as they do not love and care for each other.

Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala mentions in al-Qur'an: "The believers are but brothers, so make settlement between your brothers. And fear Allah that you may receive mercy." (al-Hujuraat 49:10)

Indeed, raising the children to be aware and having knowledge on various aspects of life is very important in preparing them to become individuals that truly understand the meaning of this life. Their awareness and consciousness upon the true

objective of the life in this world will drive them to further increase their imaan and taqwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala. Hence, we as individuals having been granted offspring and lineage by Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala



For them there will be the double reward for what they did, and they will be in the upper chambers [of Paradise], safe [and secure]." (Sabaa'34:37)




