



HOLDING FIRM UPON THE AQEEDAHOF AHLUS SUNNAH WAL JAMAA'AH



Let us all strive to increase our taqwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala with full obedience, certainty, and ikhlaas.

It is by performing all of His Commands and abstaining from all of His prohibitions. Indeed we truly hope to become individuals having utmost taqwa, with prosperity and security in this world and the Hereafter.

On this blessed day, let us contemplate upon the khutbah titled: "Holding Firm Upon The 'Ageedah Of Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa'ah."

The 'ageedah of Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa 'ah is the most dominant creed among Muslims worldwide especially in Southeast Asia including this country. Malaysia is among the nations that have

adopted the 'ageedah of Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa'ah as the official creed of its Muslim population, based on the decision and practices of the National Fatwa Council Committee, the Muftis, and

members of Malaysian Fatwa Committee. The special muzakarah (discourse) by the National Fatwa Council Committee that took place on the 5th of May, 1996 has stipulated that,

"Muslims in Malaysia must only adhere to Islamic teachings that is according to the creed of Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa 'ah in aspects of 'aqeedah, Sharee'ah, and akhlaaq."

The term Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa 'ah originated from two words, namely "Ahlus Sunnah" and "al-Jamaa 'ah," which indicates a group that adheres to the beliefs of Prophet sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam

or following his way of life sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam and his Companions radiyAllaahu 'anhum ajma 'een especially the **Rightly Guided Caliphs whom** were groomed and trained by Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam himself.

The beliefs of Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa 'ah encompasses Islamic teachings pertaining to 'aqeedah, Sharee'ah, and akhlaaq, which was taught since the time of the Prophet sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam and his Companions.

The term Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa 'ah was coined and concluded by the scholars from a hadeeth. 'Abdullah bin 'Amr radiyAllaahu 'anhuma reported that the Messenger sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam said:

"Verily, the Children of Israel had split into seventy-two sects and my ummah will split into seventy-three sects. All of them will be in Hellfire, except one group."

They (the Companions) said: "Who are they, O Messenger of Allah?" He (sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam) said: "(Those who follow) that which I and my companions follow." (at-Tirmidhi: hasan)

Based on the narration above, combined with various narrations having the same meaning, the scholars have concluded that the definition of those that strictly follow the sunnah of the Messenger and

the Companions are referred as Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa 'ah. Their 'aqeedah is deeply rooted within the teachings brought by Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam and his Companions radiyAllaahu 'anhum ajma 'een.

The 'ageedah of Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa 'ah is deemed as the teachings that is true, guided, safe, clear, and having no confusion within itself. On the contrary, all other teachings are colluded, misguided, and

erroneous, prone to stray far beyond the teachings of al-Qur'an and as-Sunnah. Among the characteristics of the creed of Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa 'ah are:

1- Firm belief and interpretation of Islamic rulings based on primary sources, namely al-Qur'an, as-Sunnah, ijmaa', and qiyaas, without rejecting or reducing the role of any one of them.

2- Firm adherence to Islamic teachings that include matters pertaining to imaan that is 'aqeedah; Islam that is shara'; and ihsaan that is akhlaaq.

3- Clinging onto al-Qur'an that was compiled by the **Companions** *radiyAllaahu* 'anhum ajma 'een especially that which is known as Mus-haf 'Uthmaani, and holding firm onto as-Sunnah especially ahaadeeth that was collected by

the great imams such as Imam al-Bukhaari, Imam Muslim, Imam at-Tirmidhi, Imam Abu Dawood, Imam an-Nasaa'ie, Imam ibn Maajah, and others that are also recognized rahimahumullah.

4- Believing that the Companions are all trustworthy and just without declaring any one of them as apostates, especially the Rightly Guided Caliphs, whom are Abu Bakr,

Umar ibn al-Khattaab, 'Uthmaan ibn 'Affaan, and 'Ali bin Abi Taalib *radiyAllaahu 'anhum ajma 'een.*

5- To believe and have firm imaan upon Unseen matters, especially those that are affirmed by al-Qur'an and as-Sunnah, such as the torment of the grave, the reward of Paradise, the torment of Hellfire, and many more.

6-Not easily and hastily declaring kufr upon the Muslims or ahlul Qiblah (those having Ka 'bah as their qiblah) except with full knowledge, established proofs, and justice.

7- Moderation in beliefs and practice, which is not being too extreme nor being negligent.

There are various other ideologies that are upheld by groups like the Shi'ah, Khawaarij, Qadariyyah, Murji'ah, Jahmiyyah, and others that have violated some or even all of the previously mentioned matters.

For example, rejecting al-Qur'an and *as-Sunnah*, interpreting Islam based on rational (reason) due to whim desire, renouncing the Companions as apostates, adopting extreme views, and others.

Hence, all of these ideologies and understanding mentioned just now are all rejected and lies outside the fold of Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa 'ah.

The established stance of the authorities and Islamic institutions in Malaysia in specifying Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa 'ah as the official creed is solely for the purpose of providing a guideline and way of life,

to be practiced by the Muslims on this land. It is evident that this attitude has brought about positive impact that is long term in uniting the Muslims and strengthening the unity and stability of the nation.

Therefore, any effort in introducing teachings and ideologies that differs with that of Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa 'ah and differs with the common practice of the local Muslim community is deemed

as an attempt to disunite the community and disrupt the stability and harmony of the country. We are truly hoping for the cooperation of all Muslims in this state to altogether

eradicate teachings and ideologies that clearly contradicts the 'aqeedah of Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa 'ah in responding to the call of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala.

This is parallel with the concept of aiding each other in performing benevolent acts and having taqwa. The conclusions to be drawn today are: 1- The 'aqeedah and creed of Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa'ah is the only belief and 'ageedah that is with

absolute certainty and guaranteed safety from the torment of the Hellfire, as mentioned by Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam.


2- The 'ageedah of Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa'ah is the official belief of Islamic institutions and the Muslims in this country that must be firmly held to and defended.

3-Any teachings, ideologies, doctrine, or understanding that contradicts and deviates from the 'ageedah of Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa 'ah must be prevented and

avoided as mentioned in fataawa issued by the Islamic Affairs Department or Mufti Department of all the states in Malaysia.

4- Any new teachings and ideologies that are deemed confusing must be referred to the National Fatwa Council, Mufti Department of respective states, qualified scholars, and Islamic institutions that are recognized by the authority.

"And if you obey most of those upon the earth, they will mislead you from the way of Allah. They follow not except assumption, and they are not but falsifying." (al-An'aam 6:116)



O Allah, You are the Almighty Lord, we are grateful unto You for having bestowed upon us **Mercy and Blessings, nourishing** us to strive to continue in strengthening the Muslim nation especially the state of Selangor, as an advanced, progressive, peaceful, and benevolent state.
