I implore all of us to strive in increasing our taqwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala by performing all of His Commands and avoiding all of His prohibitions.

Let us increase our adhkaar of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala and increase our salawaat upon our beloved Prophet Muhammad sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam, which behooves us to always

implement all of his sunnah and follow his commands. We humbly hope that these deeds will bring about benefit in this world and the Hereafter.

Da'wah in the path of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala is an obligation and 'ibaadah that is among the best of deeds when compared to other acts of 'ibaadah. This is due to the fact that da'wah is the

main duty that was fulfilled by the Messengers sent down by Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala to mankind. Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala mentions in al-Qur'an:

"O Messenger, announce that which has been revealed to you from your Lord, and if you do not, then you have not conveyed His message.

And Allah will protect you from the people. Indeed, Allah does not guide the disbelieving people." (al-Maa'idah 5:67)

This verse clearly shows that Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala had forbade Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam from concealing whatever knowledge and Sharee 'ah

that Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala had revealed to him. Moreover, it is incumbent upon him to convey the message of Islam and inviting mankind to the servitude

of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala. It is evident that the very duty of da'wah does not end with the death of Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam.

On the contrary, it is inherited and passed down to us as his ummah to continue the work of da'wah so that mankind will not deviate from the true path of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala.

The responsibility of da'wah is shouldered not only by the du 'aat and esteemed scholars, but instead it is an individual obligation that falls upon every Muslim that profess their faith,

believing in Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala and the Last Day. Every Muslim have their own unique role in the field of da wah, be it a farmer, officer, artist, community leader, and what

more for the leader of a nation. In short, regardless of occupation or status, this obligation of da'wah can never be abandoned. On the authority of 'Abdullah ibn

'Amr ibn al-'As radiyAllaahu 'anhuma that Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam said: "Convey from me, even if it is one verse.

(al-Bukhaari)

There are many techniques and approaches that can be utilized in fulfilling the obligation of da'wah, those that are compatible and appropriate in today's challenging world.

The da'wah of today is not only confined to lectures and lessons conducted in the masjid, but instead goes far beyond with the advent of electronic gadgets such as TV, the internet,

printed media, and many more. These facilities are very useful to be used as the medium in giving da'wah. The Muslim artists can convey the message of da'wah through the

television. They can produce programs portraying storieshaving elements of da'wah and beneficial advice for the viewers. They can also produce entertainment programs that would educate

the young generation in becoming closer to Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala. Those not having access to such facilities whether blue or white collar workers, community leaders, and

others, can definitely utilize the internet, printed media, and many more to propagate their message of da'wah. What is important is that the method and avenue utilized must be suitable for

the target group (mad'u) so that the message gets effectively conveyed. It is unfortunate that these facilities and avenues have been abused and misused by some in propagating ideas

that are not beneficial and even detrimental to the da wah efforts in the broadcasting media, by transmitting programs filled with superstition and mythos, also storylines that would further corrupt the morals of the youth.

The printed media and internet has been misused by some to widely spread fitnah, defamation, slandering, and others, only to notoriously degrade and humiliate those that are

innocent. It is incumbent that these abuses be rectified so that the general public can greatly benefit from the technological advancements that are readily available.

Aside from the electronic media, there are also various ways that can be utilized and having greater effect in today's da'wah effort. Among them is by becoming good example and having sound akhlaaq to

Indeed, good conduct and character are precious assets for each and every Muslim, in attracting others to fully comprehend the true teachings of Islam. This was proven and manifested to all

of us by Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam, that with noble akhlaaq, he was able to soften the hearts of the Arabs in embracing the teachings of Islam at the

The moral virtue of Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam was even explained by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala in al-Qur'an:

"There has certainly been for you in the Messenger of Allah an excellent pattern for anyone whose hope is in Allah and the Last Day and [who] remembers Allah often."

(al-Ahzaab 33:21)

Therefore, developing sound akhlaaq necessitates great effort and diligence. This is because such upright character would not cultivate into the hearts except for those that are accustomed to performing righteous deeds.

An important ingredient in carrying out the responsibility of da wah is that it must be done with hikmah. Any deed that is done with hikmah will result in great benefit to oneself

and others. For example, the Islamic Affairs Department of Selangor (JAIS) had organized several programs geared towards the da'wah effort such as "masjid-friendly" carnivals and sports carnivals.

Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala mentions in alQur'an:

"So by mercy from Allah,
[O Muhammad], you were
lenient with them.

And if you had been rude [in speech] and harsh in heart, they would have disbanded from about you..."

(Aali-'Imraan 3:159)

Using hikmah and forbearance in efforts of da'wah is greatly required, as it was understood from this verse. Among the best form of hikmah and having effectiveness is uttering

gentle words that will reverberateand penetrate into the hearts of the listeners. It is for this reason that Nabi Moosa 'alayhissalam beseeched Allah to grant him a perfect tongue so that his

da'wah will be accepted by Fir 'awn and his followers. His du 'a was mentioned in al-Qur'an:

"[Moses] said, "My Lord, expand for me my breast [with assurance].

And ease for me my task. And untie the knot from my tongue. That they may understand my speech.""

(Ta-ha 20:25-28)

Da'wah through kind words and utterance is definitely doable for many of us especially within the Muslim Malay society in this country.

Alhamdulillah, the Malay Muslim community is known for their high standard of politeness and gentleness. Hence, it is greatly unfortunate if this cultural tradition that has

long been embedded within the hearts of the Malay Muslims, is not fully utilized in fulfilling the obligation of da'wah in the path of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala.

Indeed, the responsibility of da'wah is an obligation that falls within the scope of jihaad fee sabeelillah. Thus, abandoning this duty will incur the Wrath of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala as it was mentioned in al-Qur'an:

"Say, [O Muhammad], "If your fathers, your sons, your brothers, your wives, your relatives, wealth which you have obtained, commerce wherein you fear decline, and dwellings

with which you are pleased are more beloved to you than Allah and His Messenger and jihad in His cause, then wait

until Allah executes His command. And Allah does not guide the defiantly disobedient people."" (at-Tawbah 9:24)

Therefore, as Muslims professing our faith in Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala, let us all utilize every medium and opportunity available to fulfill the da'wah mission that was commanded to us

by Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala. We truly and sincerely hope that with the da'wah efforts that we undertake, Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala will reward us accordingly.

"And warn by the Qur'an those who fear that they will be gathered before their Lord - for them besides Him will be no protector and no intercessor that they might become righteous."

(al-An'aam 6:51)
