



WASATIYYAH: A **KEY PILLAR FOR UNITY OF THE** UMMAH

I implore all of us to increase our taqwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala by performing all of His Commands and avoiding all of His prohibitions. Let us increase our remembrance of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala

and salawaat upon His Messenger sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam, not to mention emulating his sunnah as much as possible. We truly hope that these deeds will indeed bring about benefit in this world and the Hereafter.

The topic of today's *khutbah* is *"Wasatiyyah*: A Key Pillar For Unity Of The Ummah."

Indeed wasatiyyah is an important aspect in Islam that place justice as the focal point for humanity, as it was mentioned in al-Qur'an:

"And thus we have made you a just community that you will be witnesses over the people and the Messenger will be a witness over you..." (al-Baqarah 2:143)

Based on this verse, the scholars have interpreted wasatiyyah as being a characteristic of justice, which will make the Muslim ummah as witness in the Hereafter over those that had

deviated from the Truth and vehemently opposed the Messengers sent down by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala. In a broader meaning, wasatiyyah encompasses several aspects, namely:

1-Justice 2-Truth 3- Balance 4- Completeness (perfection) 5- Fulfills the *fitrah* (natural disposition of mankind)

Wasatiyyah is also an important practice for it will greatly assist in achieving unity within the ummah of humanity in general. With this trait, one will highly prioritize the taqwa of Allah

Subhaanahu Wata'aala without distinguishing the race, ethnicity, culture, language, and skin color of others. Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala mentions in al-Qur'an:

"O mankind, indeed We have created you from male and female and made you peoples and tribes that you may know one another. Indeed, the most noble of you in

the Sight of Allah is the most righteous of you. Indeed, Allah is Knowing and Acquainted."

(al-Hujuraat 49:13)

Wasatiyyah in its true and absolute sense is of a pivotal role as a distinguishing factor in the ummah's unity, after all of its requirements are met and well-practiced by all walks and levels of

today's society. From among the requirement that it entails is that we must always be just according to the Sharee 'ah of Islam; whether in making a decision, resolving disagreements, and

granting the rights upon those deserving of it. Wasatiyyah also necessitate that we become diligent, determined, and having istigaamah, in line with the Sharee 'ah of Islam that was

taught by Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam without neglecting or reducing anything from it. Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala mentions in al-Qur'an:

"... And whatever the Messenger has given you take; and what he has forbidden you - refrain from. And fear Allah; indeed, Allah is severe in penalty."

(al-Hashr 59:7)

It is clear that the wasatiyyah conveyed by Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam is to simply and solely fulfill the fitrah of the entire humanity.

As Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala had mentioned in al-Qur'an: "So direct your face toward the religion, inclining to truth. [Adhere to] the fitrah nf

Allah upon which He has created [all] people. No change should there be in the creation of Allah. That is the correct religion, but most of the people do not know."

(ar-Room 30:30)

Wasatiyyah indirectly teaches us all not to go overboard, and not becoming obsessed or ta 'assub (fanatical) that we would deny the truth in any situation or circumstances.

These negative attitude and demeanor will indeed dampen and hamper any effort in achieving unity amongst mankind. Furthermore, it would only serve as the source

discord and conflict within today's community. In the hadeeth of Jubayr bin Mut'im radiyAllaahu 'anh, Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam said:

"He is not one of us who calls for 'asabiyyah (nationalism/tribalism), or who fights for 'asabiyyah, or who dies for 'asabiyyah." (Abu Dawood: *da 'eef*, sound meaning & supported by other texts)

The take home lesson that can be contemplated upon from today's khutbah is that wasatiyyah entails several important characteristics, making it crucial for the unity of the ummah.

Among them are: 1- Prioritizing the principles of justice in the society. 2- Prioritizing balance and harmony in life.

3- Deep conviction with the Sharee 'ah of Islam and clinging upon it without neglect. 4- Avoiding ta'assub (fanaticism) that would only harm its perpetrator and others as well.

"O you who have believed, be persistently standing firm in justice, witnesses for Allah, even if it be against yourselves or parents

and relatives. Whether one is rich or poor, Allah is more worthy of both. So follow not [personal] inclination, lest you not be just.

And if you distort [your testimony] or refuse [to give it], then indeed Allah is ever, with what you do, Acquainted."

(an-Nisaa' 4:135)

protect us from Your severe tribulations such as the long drought, severe flooding, disease outbreak, violence and instability, poverty, and others, so that our land will become more peaceful and blessed.

Oh Allah, we ask You to open up the hearts of the Muslim ummah especially in Selangor, to fulfill their zakaat obligation as You had decreed in al-Qur'an. Bless the lives of those who have fulfilled their zakaat obligation, loving and caring for the poor and needy.

Purify their wealth and soul so that they will live according to that which pleases You. Protect the poor and needy from disbelief and everlasting poverty. Allaahummaa ameen
