AVOIDING SATAN'S

TEMPTATIONS

O slaves of Allah! Have the taqwa of Allah with the utmost taqwa. And do not die except in the state of Islam. I implore myself and fellow audience to increase our taqwa of Allah by

fulfilling all of His Commandments and avoiding all of His prohibitions. Let us contemplate and reflect upon today's khutbah titled, "Avoiding Satan's Temptations."

The khateeb today would like to invite the Muslimeen today to get to know closer of our archenemy that is shaytaan, furthermore so we can avoid his evil temptations in attaining

salvation in this world and the Hereafter. Shaytaan is a species of the jinn that was created from fire, whom are descendants of Iblees la 'natullah (may Allah's Curse be upon him),

always causing corruption, deceit, and whispering doubts in the hearts of mankind. From the first mankind created, shaytaan has been relentless in inciting and instigating

mankind towards disobedience and evil, preventing them from acts of obedience. This is the curse of shaytaan as Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala has mentioned in al-Qur'an:

"[Iblees] said, "By your might, I will surely mislead them all. Except, among them, Your chosen servants.""

(Saad 38:82-83)

To illustrate how significant it is for the Muslims to be extra cautious with the deceptions of shaytaan, Allah has mentioned the word shaytaan 86 times, in which 68 times it was

mentioned in the singular form "shaytaan" (شيطان) and 18 times mentioned in the plural form "shayaateen" (شياطين). No one can dispute the importance for each Muslim to avoid shaytaan's

deceptions. However, in avoiding such wickedness, it behoove us to know the methods and techniques that shaytaan employs, enabling him to slip thru inside the hearts of mankind.

Shaytaan would utilize all of our limbs in causing us to slip from the Right Path. Imaam al-Ghazzaali rahimahullah mentioned in his book Ihyaa' 'Uloom ad-Deen that just through the

"tongue" alone, shaytaan is capable of causing 20 destructions.

Dr Fathi Yakan, a well-known Muslim thinker, mentioned that there are seven areas of penetration

that shaytaan will utilize in misguiding mankind, namely: 1- Through anger When an individual is overcome with anger, it only means that the function of

the 'aql (intellect) has been greatly minimized. 'Aql is a very useful gift from Allah. It must be protected and safeguarded so that it will function towards good. When it gets sidelined,

then such are happy moments for *shaytaan* in dominating mankind.

There are those who would even murder their own siblings and parents while in the state of anger.

Unfortunately, it would only be followed with full regret once the anger dies down. Hence, when in state of anger, we are recommended to make wudoo' to "cool" the anger and protect

inner-selves from evil whisperings of shaytaan.

2- Through shahwah (lustful desire)

This refers to the urge and desire of the human body wanting to be fed with drink

and water, intercourse, wealth, and many others. The longing for these matters is not something deplorable. But shaytaan can easily manipulate such desire to misguide mankind from

the path of Allah. The desire longs for food, so shaytaan incite the individual to eat that which is haraam or take the easier route but un Islamic just to obtain that food, through cheating,

bribery, oppression, and others. Then the soul desires marital relation, so shaytaan stimulate the lust to leer at the beauty of women he is not married to, unlawfully gazing at the 'awrah

others, and many more.

3- Through recklessness and haphazard.

The characteristic of al-'ajalah (العجلة), meaning greed or recklessness, is the opposite of being careful and

cautious. Being greedy and reckless will truly make one very vulnerable to the trickery of shaytaan. This is because one will pursue something haphazardly without making rational and

sound evaluation using their 'aql. That is why we are warned and prohibited from accepting and believing any information received from doubtful sources, without further investigation.

Shaytaan will always strive for that opportunity and space to create discord among mankind. Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala mentions in al-Qur'an:

"O you who have believed, if there comes to you a disobedient one with information, investigate, lest you harm a people out of ignorance and become, over what you have done, regretful." (al-Hujuraat 49:6)

4- Through hasad (envy). This is from among the early traits of Iblees la 'natullah in his first encounter with Nabi Adam 'alayhissalam. Iblees felt jealous, arrogant, and cocky when he was

commanded by Allah to prostrate down to Adam who is "inferior" than him, being his "junior".

Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala mentions in al-Qur'an:

"[Allah] said, "What prevented you from prostrating when I commanded you?" [Satan] said, "I am better than him. You created me from fire and created him from clay.""

(al-A'raaf 7:12)

Shaytaan also attempts to instill this very characteristic inside our hearts. So when mankind is entrapped with hasad, it brings joyful feeling for shaytaan to further instigate in escalating

disputes among mankind. 5- Through bakheel (miserly). Indeed, shaytaan would always stir up anxiety in our hearts, fearing poverty and destitution.

The fear of destitution would only prevent mankind from giving sadaqah, making donation, and others. It also weakens the sympathy and benevolence towards others within our inner-selves.

In al-Qur'an, Allah mentions such deceitful trickery of shaytaan in this regard: "Satan threatens you with poverty and orders

you to immorality, while Allah promises you forgiveness from Him and bounty. And Allah is all-Encompassing and Knowing."

(al-Baqarah 2: 268)

6- Through takabbur (pride) Takabbur is a praiseworthy attribute for Allah, for He Alone is truly deserving of glorifying and exalting Himself.

However, when created beings make such claim of this characteristic, then it becomes evil and wicked. This is also from among the characteristics of shaytaan that caused him to he

deprived of the rahmah of Allah and accursed eternally. Therefore, anyone immersed in vanity or conceit, then it only brings happiness for shaytaan to seep through this pride and destroy the deeds

and 'ibaadah of the children of Adam. In a hadeeth qudsi narrated by Abu Hurayrah radiyAllaahu 'anh, Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam said:

"Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala said: 'Pride is My cloak and greatness is My robe, and he who competes with Me in respect of either of them, I shall cast into the Hell Fire."

(Abu Dawood: saheeh)

7- Suspicion towards Muslims. Suspicion is a reprehensible trait that will cause one to always look down and negatively upon other Muslims, even without proof

or evidence to substantiate such purview. It will cause one to always strive in finding the faults of others. The Messenger sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam would always remind his

Companions radiyAllaahu 'anhum ajma 'een to conceal and cover the faults of their Muslim brethren if the fault does not cause harm to the public.

Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala mentions in al-Qur'an: "O you who have believed, avoid much [negative] assumption. Indeed, some assumption is sin.

And do not spy or backbite each other. Would one of you like to eat the flesh of his brother when dead? You would detest it.

And fear Allah; indeed, Allah is Accepting of repentance and Merciful."

(al-Hujuraat 49:12)

After knowing the paths and avenues that paves the way for shaytaan to "sneak" into the human soul, then let us be on guard in protecting our own selves from falling into the deceptions of shaytaan.

"Did I not enjoin upon you, O children of Adam, that you not worship Satan – [for] indeed, he is to you a clear enemy. And that

you worship [only] Me? This is a straight path. And he had already led astray from among you much of creation, so did you not use reason?"

(Ya-Seen 36:60-62)
