



SPOUSE SELECTION – A DETERMINING FACTOR IN RAISING A GENERATION OF EXCELLENCE



I implore all of us to strive to increase our taqwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala by fulfilling all of His Commands and abstaining from all of His prohibitions.

Let us increase our remembrance of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala and salawaat and salaam upon our beloved Prophet Muhammad sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam.

We must always strive to implement all of his sunnah in our daily lives. Indeed, with these efforts we truly hope that we will attain benefit in this world and in the Hereafter.

The topic of today's khutbah is "Spouse Selection -A Determining Factor In Raising A Generation Of Excellence."

Islam place heavy emphasis with regard to spouse selection for they will be entrusted to form a family that is upon imaan in Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala. The believing family is the very

foundation for nurturing a generation that will later inherit the glory of the ummah of today. The basis in choosing a spouse has been thoroughly elaborated in the hadeeth of

Abu Hurayrah *radiyAllaahu* 'anh, where Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam stated:

"A woman is married for four things, i.e., her wealth, her family status,

her beauty and her religion. So you should marry the religious woman (otherwise) you will be a loser."

(al-Bukhaari and Muslim)

Based on this hadeeth, it can be understood that Islam has provided guidelines and recommendations for selecting a suitable spouse, in ensuring the well being of oneself and the family.

The most important criteria highlighted is choosing a spouse that is constantly upright upon the religion, having virtuous akhlaaq. In another hadeeth narrated by Abu Hurayrah radiyAllaahu

'anh, Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam said: "If there comes to you with a proposal of marriage one with whose religious commitment and attitude you are pleased,

then marry [your daughter or female relative under your care] to him, for if you do not do that, there will be fitnah (tribulation) on earth and widespread corruption." (at-Tirmidhi and ibn Maajah: saheeh)

Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi wasallam has enjoined his ummah to emphasize on the religious aspect when selecting the potential spouse. This is because religious background plays

a vital role in developing the family institution, hence producing a generation of excellence both physically and spiritually. It is undeniable that wealth, lineage, and beauty are

aspects that can fulfill human's instinctive need and desire, but in reality they cannot guarantee salvation in this world, what more in the Hereafter. Therefore, it is clear-cut that religion is of

utmost criteria when selecting one's spouse.

There are few more matters that can serve as guidelines and recommendations in selecting a spouse. We are encouraged to find a spouse

that has no family ties or from distant kinsfolk, someone that hails from a large family with many offspring. This is consistent with the hadeeth of Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi

that states:

"Marry the loving and childbearing woman, for I shall outstrip the other nations with your numbers on the Day of Judgment."

(Abu Dawood, an-Nasaa'ie, Ahmad, ibn Hibbaan: *saheeh*)

Actually, Islam does not prevent Muslims from marrying someone deemed as being young, beautiful, and charming. This is as it was narrated when Rasulullah sallAllahu 'alayhi

wasallam suggested to Jaabir bin 'Abdullah radiyAllaahu 'anh who had married a widow: "... Why did you not marry a virgin whom you could play with and she could play with you? ..."

(al-Bukhaari and Muslim)

This is because it is from human fitrah to incline to beauty and wealth. Furthermore, it is undeniable that wealth is a necessity nowadays that can help the married couple in attaining

happiness in their lives. But it must be comprehended that nothing will become meaningful until the religious aspect is given priority. Thus, some of the guidelines and recommendations outlined

for the Muslim *ummah*, especially in choosing their spouse.

Marriage that is built upon the religious foundation will help to avoid breakdowns in the family institution.

In other words, it can help prevent future problems such as inheritance disputes, conflicts between parents and children, divorce, and many others. These instances will definitely leave negative

effects upon the generations that will succeed us in the future. The objective of selecting the right spouse is not only to satisfy the carnal desire and for solely building a

household. Instead, what is more important is that it is closely related with developing a generation with the progenies bestowed by Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala.

Therefore, all the guidelines and recommendations mentioned simply and solely intend to ensure that our descendants will attain adequate protection and care so that they will become

become individuals of excellence, physically and spiritually. Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala mentions in al-Qur'an: "O mankind, fear your Lord, who created you

from one soul and created from it its mate and dispersed from both of them many men and women. And fear Allah, through whom you ask one another, and the wombs. Indeed Allah is ever, over you, an Observer."

(an-Nisaa' 4:1)

Since parents are the very foundation in nurturing the akhlaaq and excellence of the children, therefore it behoove them to undertake sufficient preparation in fulfilling this great

responsibility, entrusted to them by Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala. Among the necessary preparations are: 1- Striving to increase the knowledge that will further strengthen imaan in Allah

Subhaanahu Wata 'aala. Authentic religious knowledge is very important to be sought, pondered upon, and practiced by every individual. This is because it is the strongest line of

defense in wading through the challenges of life. With sound Islamic knowledge and understanding, the parents will be able to inculcate akhlaaq and upright values to the children

grooming them to become the generation possessing excellent character and persona.

2- Becoming well versed in the knowledge of parenting. We must realize that the duty

and responsibility of parents in raising the children are daunting; it will later determine their good or bad in the future. Hence, before agreeing to accept the challenge to shoulder

the amaanah from Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala, every husbands and wives must equip themselves with the knowledge of children's education. The knowledge of these sciences will help to

ensure our offspring become individuals of true excellence. 3- The husband and wife must be susceptible and well informed with the world's current development,

whether through reading, observation, and others. Their awareness in the advancement of the increasingly sophisticated world of science and technology will enable them

to monitor and supervise the children effectively. Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala mentions in al-Qur'an: "Wealth and children are [but] adornment of the

worldly life. But the enduring good deeds are better to your Lord for reward and better for [one's] hope."

(al-Kahf 18:46)

To end today's khutbah, it can be concluded that choosing one's spouse is really a matter of great importance for it will truly affect the formation of a generation of excellence.

Thus, selecting a spouse should be based on the religious recommendations as follows: 1- Choosing a spouse that is a true believer with sound akhlaaq.

- 2- Choosing a spouse without close family relationship.
 - 3- Choosing a spouse from a good lineage and large in number (fertile).

4- Those intending to pursue polygamy should also adhere to the selection criteria previously mentioned.

Hopefully with proper and sound spouse selection, according to the criteria outlined in Islam, it will result with blissfulness in this life, furthermore

producing a generation of excellent progenies that will greatly serve the religion, ummah, and nation.

"And know that your properties and your children are but a trial and that Allah has with Him a great reward."

(al-Anfaal 8:28)
