




STEADFASTNESS

IN WORSHIP



Truly, may we become individuals having taqwa, attaining salvation in this world and the Hereafter. On this blessed day, let us ponder upon a khutbah entitled: "Steadfastness In Worship."

Indeed, istiqaamah (steadfastness) or consistency in performing 'ibaadah or being in the state of obedience is something that is very difficult to achieve.

This is because imaan is actually in the heart. And the heart as it is known in Arabic as "qalbun" is defined as something having that is always vacillating. Hence, a person may have imaan in

the morning, but falls into kufr (disbelief) at night. Or being in the state of obedience in the morning, but transgresses at night. Or doing good deeds in the morning, but plunges into

heedlessness at night. Because it is the nature of the heart to always vacillate, or not istigaamah and being consistent. Anas bin Maalik radiyAllaahu 'anh narrated that Rasulullah (صلى الله) said:

"...Indeed the hearts are between the two Fingers of Allah's Fingers, He changes them as He wills."


(at-Tirmidhi: saheeh)

Istiquamah means to follow one path or remaining consistent upon one guideline. Imam an-Nawawi rahimahullaah explained istigaamah stating that: "The scholars have mentioned that

istiqaamah is to always remain in the obedience to Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala. This is the istigaamah that is emphasized by al-Qur'an and as-Sunnah."

For example, to consistently pray the fard prayer in congregation, always performing the qabliyah and ba'diyah sunnah prayers, istigaamah in covering one's 'awrah, istiqaamah in giving

away one's wealth for charity in the Path of Allah, and many others. Indeed, istiqaamah is truly difficult. That is why Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala has promised a huge reward for



"Indeed, those who have said, "Our Lord is Allah," and then remained on a right course - the angels will descend upon them,

[saying], "Do not fear and do not grieve but receive good tidings of Paradise, which you were promised.""

(Fussilat 61:30)

Indeed, istigaamah is heavily emphasized in our religion. Istiquamah is truly emphasized in Islam, as it was decreed by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala and His Messenger.

Among them is the verse in al-Qur'an:

"So remain on a right course as you have been commanded, [you] and those who have turned back with you [to Allah],

and do not transgress. Indeed, He is Seeing of what you do."

(Hood 11:112)

Among ahaadeeth that mentions istigaamah is the narration by Sufyaan bin 'Abdullah ath-Thaqafi radiyAllaahu 'anh, whom reported:

I said, "O Messenger of Allah, tell me something of Islam which I will not ask anyone else about it." He (عليه وسلم) said, "Say, 'I believe in Allah' and then be steadfast."

(Muslim)

Through the selected verses and this hadeeth, it is evident that istiquamah is a command from Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala. While the hadeeth explains that the key to success or

living guidelines in attaining the pleasure of Allah is achieved through istiqaamah. Furthermore, the explanation from Rasulullah (عليه وسلم) in answering the Companion's question truly

emphasize that in order for one to excel and succeed in this world and Hereafter, it must be with solid imaan and continuous deeds with consistency or istiqaamah.

Among matters that hinders istiqaamah is when one deem sinning and disobedience as something light, always busy with worldly affairs without concerning about the

Hereafter, and surrounded with bad environment whether having immoral companions, broken homes, or living in an 'uncivilized' society. All these are among the factors that would cripple

one's effort for istigaamah in preserving obedience unto Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala. Among the characteristics of istigaamah, whether through the actions of the heart,

tongue, and limbs, in continuously remaining in obedience are: 1- Obedience with full mujaahadah in fighting against the nafs. Indeed, imaan increases and

decreases. Hence, the Muslim must remain mujaahadah in performing the obligatory 'ibaadah, and perfecting them with supererogatory acts.

2- Always attending knowledgeoriented activities. Indeed, knowledge is the key to all goodness. With knowledge, one will come to know, worship, and devote oneself to Allah

Subhaanahu Wata'aala. With knowledge, one will know his obligations upon Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala. With knowledge, fulfilling the obligation towards Allah Subhaanahu

Wata 'aala will become easy, beautiful, and enjoyable. 3- Ikhlaas (sincerity) in seeking knowledge and practicing them. Verily, ikhlaas is the soul of all 'ibaadah. When ikhlaas is

fertile and cultivated in the heart, then 'ibaadah will continue to flourish, stemming from the heart.

4-Befriending or being in the company of the righteous.
Indeed, being in

the company of the righteous can strengthen one's enthusiasm to continue remaining in the obedience of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala. Furthermore, even a good environment

would suffice to save us from heedlessness, what more if we are always in the company of those having good conduct, righteous, and obedient to Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala.

5- Moderation in religious practice and behavior. Indeed, moderation in religious practice according to one's ability becomes the savior from feeling fatigue or boredom, which in the

end prompts one to abandon them entirely. Verily, a good practice would be low in quantity but performed continuously. Insha Allah, a small beginning will definitely result in

multitudes when it becomes a habit.

Among other deeds that would aid in istiqaamah is to always engage in istighfaar, du 'aa, adhkaar, remembering death, making

tawbah, and yearning to die having the Pleasure of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala. Among the benefits of istigaamah is that one will always remain in the company of the angels of

mercy, one's heart and life engulfed in peace and happiness, and even paradise is guaranteed for him and his rizq expanded by Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala.

Let us altogether remain determined and committed towards obedience by creating a righteous or conducive environment so that it will stimulate and encourage goodness for all

of us. May we always remain in obedience, forgiveness, and mercy of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala. The conclusions that can be derived from today's khutbah are as follows:

1- We must always remain istiqaamah in fulfilling religious duties decreed by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala through the verses of al-Qur'an and the عليه وسلم) sunnah of Rasulullah (عليه وسلم).

2- We must always be in the company of the scholars and the righteous and frequent circles of knowledge to discipline the soul in attaining blissfulness in this world and the Hereafter.

3- We must always make du 'aa to Allah so that we will forever remain in obedience and standing firm until we breathe our last.

"[Who say], "Our Lord, let not our hearts deviate after You have guided us and grant us from Yourself mercy. Indeed, You are the Bestower.""

made waqfand gave up their wealth for the Tabung Amanah Pembangunan Islam Selangor (Islamic Development Trust Fund of Selangor) with continuous reward until the Day of Judgment.
