

INTERNATIZING INIEGRIYIN OURLIVES



I remind myself and my beloved audience to strive to increase our taqwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala by fulfilling all of His Commands and avoiding all

of His prohibitions. May we all attain blissfulness in this world and the Hereafter.

Today's *khutbah* will expound on a topic titled:

"Internalizing Integrity In Our Lives."

In general, integrity refers to values pertaining to trust, trustworthiness, honesty, obedience, and firm personal characteristics. Internalizing these integrity values will lead to the formation of an

excellent persona. This is in line with Islam that teaches the Muslims to internalize noble akhlaaq as it was truly manifested by Rasulullah صلى الله). Abu Hurayrah radiyAllaahu 'anh reported

that Rasulullah (عليه وسلم) said: "I was sent to perfect good character."

(al-Bukhaari's al-Adab al-Mufrad: saheeh)

Therefore, as a Muslim, we must truly internalize values of integrity. We must always remain trustworthy, honest, just, and responsible, while manifesting praiseworthy characteristics such as

diligence, dedication, sincerity, loving each other, and being disciplined, for they are all enjoined in Islam. When these integrity values have been successfully cultivated and

practiced, it will then produce families, workers, and societies having upright personalities.

The absence of the internalization of integrity values will have a great impact in our lives. Among those effects that should be taken seriously:

1-The increase in bribery, corruption, and power abuse. Integrity is often associated with the issue of bribery. Bribery is haraam and it contradicts the Shara'.

The one giving or receiving bribery has actually committed a major sin, and they are both cursed. 'Abdullah ibn 'Amr radiyAllaahu 'anhuma narrated:

The Messenger of Allah (صلى الله) cursed the one who bribes and the one who takes a bribe."

(at-Tirmidhi, Abu Dawood, ibn Maajah, Ahmad, ibn Hibbaan: *saheeh*)

Bribery does not only refer to the financial aspects, but instead has a broader definition which covers corruption and the abuse of power and position that is entrusted upon for the

benefit of one's own self, family, or certain parties. If integrity values are not internalized, then bribery will become more rampant.

2-The absence of barakah and the pleasure of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala in one's life.

When a person is void of integrity in his work, especially in terms of

fulfilling the responsibility in seeking lawful source of income by committing fraud, breaching trust, dishonesty, committing bribery, and others, then the income obtained originates from

unlawful sources. Indeed, such ways will only incur the Wrath of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala.

It was narrated in a hadeeth that Rasulullah (عليه وسلم) said:

"Every flesh that is nourished with haraam, the Fire is more befitting for 11. "

(at-Tirmidhi, al-Bayhaqi, at-Tabaraani: *saheeh*) The hadeeth indicates how the lives of these types of people will not attain barakah and the pleasure of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala. Instead, some will even be punished in this

world by facing constant difficulties, a life that is devoid of tranquility, and du'aas not being accepted by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala.

3- The Muslim nation becomes weak and exposed to various security threats We have heard of various stories from the history of human civilization such as 'Aad, Thaamood, Greeks,

Persians, and others. All were destroyed by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala due to the greed of their leaders and followers without integrity. They were overtaken by reprehensible

traits such as greed, envy, treachery, oppressive, arrogance, and many others, which only brought harm to the society and can expose the nation to security threats.

To conclude this khutbah, several measures have been identified to be inculcated and strengthen our civilization, as well as internalizing integrity values in our lives, namely:

1- The Muslim ummah must solidify its imaan and strengthen its personality for only imaan and upright persona can ensure that one remains istiquamah in inculcating praiseworthy

traits and integrity within the self. When one has imaan and integrity values, then they will serve as the most potent shield in warding off wicked practices within the society such as bribery,

power abuse, corruption, and breach of trust. Anas ibn Maalik radiyAllaahu 'anh narrated that Rasulullah (عليه وسلم) said:

"There is no faith for the one who has no amaanah

(trust) and no religion for the one who does not fulfill his promises."

(Ahmad and al-Bayhaqi)

2- The Muslim ummah must emphasize on the aspects of upbringing and education of integrity beginning from early childhood, followed by the primary, secondary, and tertiary level.

3-Law enforcement must be continuously intensified so that the society will realize upon the detrimental effect from neglecting integrity values, which can result in more crime and threatens

national security. 4- Awareness campaign in explaining integrity values must be further intensified by everyone so that it will become part and parcel of the society.

"Indeed, Allah commands you to render trusts to whom they are due and when you judge between people to judge with justice.

Excellent is that which Allah instructs you. Indeed, Allah is ever Hearing and Seeing."

(an-Nisaa' 4:58)

Once again, I would like to remind all of us that Islam teach its adherents to remain moderate in all actions and deeds. At the same time, the Muslims are to avoid any form of extremism in which its

consequences will only disrupt the harmony, unity, and security of the Muslim ummah and our nation. Extremism will only give negative impression upon the nobility and holiness of al-Islam. On the contrary, the Muslim

ummah must inculcate noble akhlaaq, having utmost personality and attitude as true Muslims so that the world will know that Rasulullah (عليه وسلم) was sent down as a messenger, and Islam that was revealed is mercy

for the entire nation and universe.

O Allah, You are the Lord that is All Mighty, we are grateful to You for having bestowed upon us rahmah and ni'mah, that we are able to continue the effort in empowering the Muslim ummah especially in Selangor, as an

advanced state, prosperous, and providing welfare. Hence, we sincerely beseech you, O Allah, strengthen our imaan, accept our deeds, strengthen our unity, increase our rizg, enrich us with

beneficial knowledge, cultivate our soul with good mannerisms, return us to the path that you are pleased with, protect us from disasters and your severe trials, so that our nation will become more peaceful and filled with blessings.

O Allah, we sincerely beseech you, strengthen our beliefs according to the creed of Ahlus Sunnah wal-Jamaa'ah, and protect us from deeds and 'ageedah that are astray such as the extreme Shee'is, Qadiyani, and other ideologies.

O Allah, open up our hearts in fulfilling the five daily prayers, performing zakaat, and other obligations. Bless those that have fulfilled their zakaat and loving the fugaraa' and masaakin, and those that have

made wagf and gave up their wealth for Tabung Amanah Pembangunan Islam Selangor (Islamic Development Trust Fund of Selangor) with continuous reward until the Hereafter.

O Allah, increase and widen the rizg of those that made wagf from their wealth with perpetual rewards until the Last Day.
