I implore all of us to strive in
increasing our *taqwa* of Allah
Subhaanahu Wata'aala by
performing all of His
Commands and avoiding all of
His

prohibitions. Let us increase
our remembrance of Allah
Subhaanahu Wata'aala and
also *salawaat* and *salaam* upon
our beloved Nabi Muhammad
(ﷺ), while always striving
our utmost in

practicing all of his sunnah.

May our effort and deeds truly benefit us in this world and the Hereafter.

Let us altogether ponder and contemplate upon today's *khutbah* entitled:

*“Sound ‘Aqeedah Leads To
Salvation.”*

'Aqeedah refers to creed and affirmation with conviction, without doubtfulness. The Islamic *'aqeedah* means to firmly believe in everything that was conveyed by Rasulullah (ﷺ) through

al-Qur'an and *as-Sunnah*.

'Aqeedah is the very essence
for the acceptance or rejection
of our deeds by Allah

Subhaanahu Wata'aala. Allah

Subhaanahu Wata'aala

mentions in al-Qur'an:

“And We will regard what they have done of deeds and make them as dust dispersed.”

(al-Furqaan 25:23)

In our lives, the Islamic
'aqeedah is the utmost matter
that must be imbued in our
souls for it is the very
foundation that produces
excellent *akhlaaq* in an
individual.

The Islamic *'aqeedah* should be inculcated right from the day when one is born into this world. That is why Rasulullah (صلى الله عليه وسلم) encouraged for the newborn infant to have the *adhaan* pronounced

in their ears, for they are both filled with words of *tawheed*.

It was reported from ibn

‘Abbaas

radiyAllaahu ‘anhuma:

Rasulullah (ﷺ) said:

**“Let the first words that
your children hear as
being: *laa ilaaha
illAllaah...*”**

(al-Bayhaqi)

Narrated Abu Raafi

‘radiyAllaahu ‘anh:

I saw the Messenger of Allah

(صلى الله عليه وسلم) uttering the call to

prayer (*adhaan*) in the ear of

**al-Hasan ibn ‘Ali when
Faatimah gave birth to him.**

(at-Tirmidhi, Abu Dawood,
Ahmad, al-Haakim, al-Bayhaqi:
hasan)

The sound *'aqeedah* will help us to obey and adhere to every single ordainment from Allah *Subhaanahu Wata'aala*. All of the commands and prohibitions from Allah *Subhaanahu*

Wata 'aala will be complied and fulfilled with perfection when solid *'aqeedah* is embedded in our hearts. Such adherence to the commands of Allah *Subhaanahu Wata 'aala* is

due to the full conviction upon
the rewards and punishments
from Allah, that we will
always remain vigilant from
falling into disobedience.
Hence, with this certainty, we
can clearly

determine our direction in this life, whether for the betterment in this world only or also in the Hereafter. Allah *Subhaanahu Wata'aala* mentions in al-Qur'an:

**“Say, [O Muhammad],
“Shall we [believers] inform
you of the greatest losers as
to [their] deeds?””**

(al-Kahf 18:103)

Ultimately, the sound '*aqeedah*
will produce individuals that
are resilient in the wake of
trials and challenges in life.

Judging from recent
happenings and phenomenon,
we clearly see

how Allah *Subhaanahu*
Wata'aala has sent down
various forms of calamities
such as severe thunderstorm,
heavy flooding, tsunami,
hurricane, and other forms just
to test the strength of our

imaan unto Allah *Subhaanahu Wata'aala*. Therefore, if we possess absolute certainty upon the Oneness and Power of Allah *Subhaanahu Wata'aala*, then it will only make us more

determined and patient in
facing tribulations, with full
certainty that Allah
Subhaanahu Wata'aala will
always be with those that are
patient.

Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala
mentions in al-Qur'an:

“Do the people think that they will be left to say, “We believe” and they will not be tried?”

(al-‘Ankaboot 29:2)

True patience will not be attained until our inner soul is filled with *'aqeedah* and certainty that is firm upon the Oneness of Allah *Subhaanahu Wata'aala*. That is why in the first 13 years,

when Rasulullah (ﷺ) was giving *da'wah* in Makkah, he worked diligently to build and solidify the *'aqeedah* of the Muslims at that time. His diligence and painstaking effort finally produced great

Companions having great determination, putting their lives on the line for the sake of Islam, with the likes of Bilaal bin Rabaah, 'Ali bin Abi Taalib, Zayd bin Haarithah, and many others

radiyAllaahu 'anhum ajma'een.

It is also important to note that sound *'aqeedah* will prevent one from resorting to all sorts of criminal activities, which would only

· destroy the Muslim *ummah*.

What is evident today is that reports and statistics regarding murder, rape, burglary, and its like appears almost on a daily basis on TV, newspapers, and other

media outlets. Why are these crimes happening? Definitely because the soul is not properly equipped with solid *'aqeedah* and conviction upon punishments that would be

inflicted for evil done in this world. Allah *Subhaanahu Wata'aala* mentions in al-

Qur'an:

“If you could but see when the criminals are hanging their heads before their

**Lord, [saying], “Our Lord,
we have seen and heard, so
return us [to the world]; we
will work righteousness.**

**Indeed, we are [now]
certain.””**

(as-Sajdah 31:12)

The sound '*aqeedah* will help prevent any form of corruption or deviation from authentic Islamic teachings. It is the weak '*aqeedah* that leads to the corruption within Islamic teachings.

The failure of some Muslims
to properly comprehend the
true *tawheed* of Allah
Subhaanahu Wata'aala has
opened up holes for
propaganda and manipulation
engineered by

the enemies of Islam in poisoning the Muslim minds. These Muslims often become confused between authentic Islamic teachings and deceptions that are deemed as being part of the

religion. In the end, they become astray and drowned in misguidance. Hence, it is of no surprise that we find many groups and sects declared as deviants by the Office of the Mufti in

numerous states, due to the corruption in their religious practice. In Selangor alone, there are no less than 30 religious sects, teachings, or practices that have been declared as deviating and

astray, among them being
Shee'ism, anti-*hadeeth*,
liberalism, pluralism, and
many others. Allah
Subhaanahu Wata'aala
mentions in al-Qur'an:

**“But those who disbelieved -
their deeds are like a mirage
in a lowland which a thirsty
one thinks is water until,
when he comes to it, he finds
it is nothing but finds Allah
before Him,**

**and He will pay him in full
his due; and Allah is swift in
account.”**

(an-Noor 24:39)

Therefore, as Muslims that truly believe upon the existence and greatness of Allah *Subhaanahu Wata'aala*, let us strive in strengthening our own *'aqeedah*, the *'aqeedah* of

our families and communities,
for it is only with *sound*
'aqeedah that salvation is
attained in this world and the
Hereafter.

From today's *khutbah*, there are few lessons worth noting, namely:

1- The Muslim *ummah* must strive to nurture and solidify '*aqeedah Islamiyyah* by fulfilling all ordainments

from Allah *Subhaanahu*
Wata 'aala and avoiding His
prohibitions.

2- The Muslim *ummah* must
strive to increase their
comprehension of '*aqeedah*
Islamiyyah so as to avoid

any form of misguidance and deviation.

3- The Muslim *ummah* must always strive to protect its '*aqeedah* by increasing good deeds and perfecting the *akhlaaq*.

4- The Muslim *ummah* must always remain cognizant on the significance between good deeds and sinning, and between Paradise and Hellfire, while conducting their daily affairs.

**“Yes [on the contrary],
whoever submits his face in
Islam to Allah while being a
doer of good will have his
reward with his Lord. And
no fear will**

**there be concerning them,
nor will they grieve.”**

(al-Baqarah 2:112)

us *rahmah* and *ni'mah*, that we
are able to continue the effort
in empowering the Muslim
ummah especially in Selangor,
as an**

**advanced state, prosperous,
and providing welfare.**

**Hence, we sincerely beseech
you, O Allah, strengthen our
imaan, accept our deeds,
strengthen our unity, increase
our *rizq*, enrich us with**

**beneficial knowledge, cultivate
our soul with good mannerisms,
return us to the path that you
are pleased with, protect us
from disasters and your severe
trials, so that our nation will
become more peaceful and filled
with blessings.**

O Allah, we sincerely beseech you, strengthen our beliefs according to the creed of *Ahlu Sunnah wal-Jamaa'ah*, and protect us from deeds and *'aqeedah* that are astray such as the extreme *Shee'is*, *Qadiyani*, and other ideologies.

O Allah, open up our hearts in fulfilling the five daily prayers, performing *zakaat*, and other obligations. Bless those that have fulfilled their *zakaat* and loving the *fuqaraa'* and *masaakin*, and those that have

**made *waqf* and gave up their
wealth for *Tabung Amanah
Pembangunan Islam Selangor*
(Islamic Development Trust
Fund of Selangor) with
continuous reward until the
Hereafter.**

**O Allah, increase and widen the
rizq of those that made *waqf*
from their wealth with
perpetual rewards until the
Last Day.**
