



DHIKRULLAAH NURTURES AKHLAAQ AND REFORMLIVES



I remind myself and my beloved audience to strive to increase our taqwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala by fulfilling all of His Commands and avoiding all

of His prohibitions. Indeed, the noble ones in the Sight of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala are those having utmost taqwa, for taqwa is the apex of humanity that will elevate one in attaining

favorable and absolute judgment from Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala. Taqwa will cause the Muslim to be ennobled by Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala always.

Let us have istigaamah in fulfilling the Sharee 'ah that was decreed by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala, for the sake of attaining the pleasure of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala

so that we will always attain barakah and success in this world and the Hereafter, inshaa Allaah. The title of today's khutbah is: "Dhikrullaah Nurtures Akhlaaq And Reform Lives."

Dhikrullaah is the remembrance of Allah upon the tongue and through actions, whether zhaahir (external) or baatin (internal). By having the dhikr of Allah, we will

always maintain that connection with Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala. Indeed, this is from among the characteristic of those having taqwa. Truly, dhikr has a very wide scope,

which encompasses all actions, whether external or internal, for as long as it alludes to the remembrance of Allah. This includes when we utter the word Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala

specifically, performing the obligatory and supererogatory salaah especially during the last third of the night, fasting, fulfilling zakaah, reciting al-Qur'an, seeking knowledge

that are fard al-'ayn and fard al-kifaayah, making du'aa, avoiding acts of disobedience, seeking halaal provision, pondering and reflecting upon the creations of Allah Subhaanahu

Wata 'aala, while glorifying and exalting Him at the same time. Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala mentions in al-Qur'an:

"Who remember Allah while standing or sitting or

[lying] on their sides and give thought to the creation of the heavens and the earth, [saying], "Our Lord, You did not create this aimlessly; exalted are You [above such a thing]; then

protect us from the punishment of the Fire.""

(Aal-'Imraan 3:191)

Making dhikr has its adaab that must be observed. Among them is to pronounce phrases such as "Laa ilaaha illAllaah" in its proper way, making dhikr while the heart and emotions are in the state

of purity and cleansed. While making dhikr, we can feel the greatness and mightiness of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala. Furthermore, the dhikr should be done with a low

voice, sufficient to be heard by the doer alone. We are to make dhikr with utterances that are authentically reported from al-Qur'an and as-Sunnah. These adaab must be adhered to so

we can manifest the noble akhlaaq and remain disciplined while making dhikr, so as to attain perfection in dhikr, in accordance to the sunnah of Rasulullah (عليه وسلم).

With that, inshaa Allaah our dhikr will be accepted by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala.

How is it that dhikr can nurture akhlaaq? The answer is very simple. Is it not the case that the one making dhikr is in the remembrance of Allah? If he remembers Allah, then it also means that

he is fully cognizant of the commands and Sharee 'ah ordained by Allah. The akhlaaq and behavior of one that is vigilant and fearful of disobeying Allah definitely will be unwilling to resort to

anything contradicting His Commands. This was the practice of Rasulullah (عليه وسلم), his Companions radiyAllaahu 'anhum ajma 'een, and also those that truly love Allah and Islam.

We will find such phenomenon when we truly study the lives of Rasulullah (صلى الله), his Companions, and the muttagoon.

When one is in the constant remembrance of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala, he will have certainty with all decree determined by Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala. This will make him honest,

trustworthy, responsible, disciplined, and always upholding noble values in his interactions with the society such as having patience, compassion, and loving towards everyone and

all creatures existing on earth. Hence, the one in constant dhikr will truly taste and enjoy tranquility that will enable them to fulfill their responsibility as a slave that is always seeking the

pleasure of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala. Therefore, definitely the noble akhlaaq will be nurtured. If one is always making dhikr but at the same time commit acts of

disobedience, then definitely something is not right with such person. Hence, something is to be done such as muhaasabah or self-evaluation in seeking the root cause.

When virtuous akhlaaq is cemented, then inshaa Allaah life will transform for the better, in accordance with the Sharee 'ah. Such is because among the effects of those in constant dhikr is that

Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala will protect them from matters that He hates. They will be able to control their hawaa (desire) to always performing good deeds only.

Moreover, they will be able to control themselves from temptations of iblees and shayaateen. Those in constant dhikr will be able to revive their hearts and, inshaa Allaah,

spared from negligence and heedlessness, for their hearts will always remain pleased, ganaa'ah (satisfied), and satiated with whatever provision and qadr (decree) bestowed by Allah

Subhaanahu Wata'aala. Dhikr can be done in various forms except for the prohibited areas such as in the toilet. The one making dhikr does not need to relinquish his daily affairs,

thus affecting his source of income for his livelihood. Furthermore, one can still remain in dhikr while engaging in daily affairs. This is the misunderstanding that must be corrected so that

the life of a Muslim will always remain in the remembrance of Allah, for the sake of attaining His Pleasure Subhaanahu Wata'aala.

As an overview of today's *khutbah*, the Muslims are recommended to:

1- Always remain in the remembrance of Allah, so that Allah will always remember us, so remember

Him always.

2- Perform daily adhkaar (plural of dhikr) and incorporating dhikr as part of our daily affairs, at all times. 3- Seek tranquility through dhikr and obedience to Allah

Subhaanahu Wata'aala.

"So remember Me; I will remember you. And be grateful to Me and do not deny Me."

(al-Baqarah 2:152)

At the same time, the Muslims are to avoid any form of extremism in practicing and upholding Islam. The Muslim ummah should become the exemplary nation that brings mercy to the entire universe.

O Allah, You are the Lord that is All Mighty, we are grateful to You for having bestowed upon us rahmah and ni'mah, that we are able to continue the effort in empowering the Muslim ummah especially in Selangor, as an

advanced state, prosperous, and providing welfare.

Hence, we sincerely beseech you, O Allah, strengthen our imaan, accept our deeds, strengthen our unity, increase our rizg, enrich us with

beneficial knowledge, cultivate our soul with good mannerisms, return us to the path that you are pleased with, protect us from disasters and your severe trials, so that our nation will become more peaceful and filled with blessings.

O Allah, we sincerely beseech you, strengthen our beliefs according to the creed of Ahlus Sunnah wal-Jamaa'ah, and protect us from deeds and 'ageedah that are astray such as the extreme Shee'is, Qadiyani, and other ideologies.

O Allah, open up our hearts in fulfilling the five daily prayers, performing zakaat, and other obligations. Bless those that have fulfilled their zakaat and loving the fugaraa' and masaakin, and those that have

made waqf and gave up their wealth for Tabung Amanah Pembangunan Islam Selangor (Islamic Development Trust Fund of Selangor) with continuous reward until the Hereafter.

O Allah, increase and widen the rizg of those that made waqf from their wealth with perpetual rewards until the Last Day.
