


## IGILANCE WHEN USING SOCIAL MEDIA



May we all be among His slaves whom are granted His blessings and love, as well as His protection, Subhaanahu Wata 'aala.

On this blessed Friday, the chief of all days (sayyid alayyaam), let us internalize upon the khutbah entitled: "Vigilance When Using Social Media."

The globalized world today is witnessing the rapid growth of social media. All walks of life, whether young or old, children or adult, male or female, no one wants to be left out in

utilizing new social media applications such as facebook, twitter, blog, sms, and many more. Up until January 2012, about 62% of Malaysia's population of 29 million people was identified

as internet users. From that data, about 87.9% of those internet users actually have a facebook account, while 67% of them regularly watch Youtube. The latest statistics revealed that about 7.9 new

facebook accounts are registered every second. Furthermore, facebook tops the list as the most popular online social network in Malaysia.

Indeed, Islam does not impede on progress or modernization, but it is not unreasonable to state that the blessing of social media today has pretty much flipped around creating a

phenomenon that is very worrying. Many elements of wickedness have surfaced, grown, spread, and plagued our society through the social media. Not only the 'awrah is uncovered all over

the place, but exposing and disgracing others openly has become common. Slander, accusations, and spreading unverified information have become the cause of fights between spouses and within

of vulgarities and obscenities has become the norm within the culture of social media.

The Muslim ummah today spends a lot of time browsing through the social media compared to the time spent browsing on verses of the Holy Qur'an. The question begs how many of

us actually browse through materials that pertain to spirituality, religion, and good akhlaaq? How much materials or contents that are related to da'wah, advice, or noble akhlaaq that are fed to

us via social media? Every time we "click" or browse through our social media page, does that "click" or browsing lead to goodness or disobedience? Are all of these truly investments for

the Hereafter that are truly beneficial, or only adds up to our burden of sins that are already heavy and laden?

Indeed, Allah has elevated us with the intellect, bestowing upon us blessings that are uncountable. However, the effect of the cyberspace at times becomes successful in turning us into a creation

with a foul mouth and filthy pen, lying and transgressing, hasty, impetuous, always rushing, weak, and disordered. Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala mentions in al-Qur'an:

"And of the people is he who buys the amusement of speech to mislead [others] from the way of Allah without knowledge and who

## takes it in ridicule. Those will have a humiliating punishment."

(Luqmaan 31:6)

It must be remembered that the blessings of the intellect ('aql) has elevated the status of mankind over other creations. It is with this 'aql that mankind was successful in producing many

inventions to be used on land, in the air, and in the sea. Ponder upon the capability of the human intellect that has turned today's world into a tiny village without distance and

borders through technological advancement of the social media such as facebook, WhatsApp, and others, all of which were inspirations from the intellect that was bestowed

by Allah upon humans. It is the *agl* that will steer technology heading towards either good or evil. Al-Imaam al-Ghazzaali rahimahullaah had once said:

'A job is considered a virtue if it fulfils the need of the 'agl and religion, and it is deemed as harmful if it violates the demand of the 'aql and religion."

All these indicate that in handling this social media phenomenon, both the intellect and religion must go hand in hand. Whatever news and story that appears in social media will create


harmony if it is processed by an 'aql that is religion-driven. The wisdom in processing news and stories necessitates bashfulness and taqwa, from exposing their eyes and ears to matters that

humiliate others. Feeling fearful and ashamed to Allah if the hand and fingers of those spreading and sharing information that has yet to be confirmed of its authenticity. Feeling worried that our

limbs and faculty of senses will become witnesses and proof of evilness in front of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala on the Day of Recompense. Are we not afraid that our good deeds

will render in vain just because we mistakenly "shared" a piece of information or sharing wickedness all over the place. Elements of religion, intellect, humility, and

taqwa, if all combined upon receiving any information, it will become the key to happiness in this world and the Hereafter. Let us be fearful with the admonishment from



(al-Anfaal 8:22)

Day after day, this phenomenon is becoming increasingly worrying with more than 370 porn sites accessible on the internet. More than 2.5 billion emails that are sent daily are

actually pornographic materials. Even saddening is that a newspaper publication has reported that Malaysia is ranked eighth in the world in online search for pornography on the internet.

There is a credible research which concluded that 60% of teenagers committed zinaa (fornication) due to watching pornography on the internet. The reality in Malaysia today is that 90% of school

students actually browse through porn sites unintentionally because those sites are hiding behind "appropriate" websites and terminologies.

This is the reality that must be confronted thoroughly so that the imaan that has been built for many years will not be easily torn because of a picture or news piece. In the wake of multitudes of news

and stories spawning all over the social media and its like, let us reinvigorate ourselves, our children, and those around us with a message from Allah that we remain cautious with every news

that are conveyed to us. Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala mentions in al-Qur'an: "O you who have believed, if there comes to you a disobedient one with

information, investigate, lest you harm a people out of ignorance and become, over what you have done, regretful."

(al-Hujuraat 49:6)

Let us build a wall so that we vill not violate the prohibition from Allah in avoiding suspicion. Let us abstain as much as possible from partaking in eating the flesh of our brothers.

Let us nourish our imaan and taqwa so that we will attain Allah's love and forgiveness, which are truly precious. Hence, let us contemplate upon the hadeeth of Abu Hurayrah radiyAllaahu'anh,

whom reported that Rasulullah صلى الله as saying: "A slave of Allah may utter a word without thinking whether it is right or wrong, he may slip down in the Fire as far away

# distance equal to that between the east and the west."

(Agreed Upon)

## Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala had also reminded us in al-Qur'an:

"Man does not utter any word except that with him is an observer prepared [to record]."

(Qaaf 50:18)

To conclude the khutbah on this noble day, let us ensure that we ourselves, our children, our spouses, our relatives, our colleagues, and our companions are all social media users that truly abide

by the Sharee 'ah of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala. Just like grocery items that we intend to purchase in the supermarket, we would first scrutinize, observe, and compare its price and quality

### so that we will not incur any loss. Therefore:

1. Let us ensure that the time spent on social media will act as a bridge towards good and investment for the Hereafter.

2. Let us train our fingers to only write or type matters that are good and beneficial so that our mizaan (scale) will be heavy with hasanaat (good deeds) in front of Allah Subhaanahu

#### Wata 'aala.

Let us hasten to develop our imaan and hearts in avoiding fitnah, slander, abuses, insults, and enmity amongst mankind, and remain fearful in dragging

along all of our evil deeds hidden within the social media when facing Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala on that Day.

"That Day, the people will depart separated [into categories] to be shown [the result of] their deeds. So whoever does an atom's weight of

### good will see it. And whoever does an atom's weight of evil will see it."

(al-Zalzalah 99:6-8)

ummah must inculcate noble akhlaaq, having utmost personality and attitude as true Muslims so that the world will know that Rasulullah (عليه وسلم) was sent down as a messenger, and Islam that was revealed is mercy



O Allah, You are the Lord that is All Mighty, we are grateful to You for having bestowed upon us rahmah and ni'mah, that we are able to continue the effort in empowering the Muslim ummah especially in Selangor, as an

advanced state, prosperous, and providing welfare. Hence, we sincerely beseech you, O Allah, strengthen our imaan, accept our deeds, strengthen our unity, increase our rizg, enrich us with

beneficial knowledge, cultivate our soul with good mannerisms, return us to the path that you are pleased with, protect us from disasters and your severe trials, so that our nation will become more peaceful and filled with blessings.

O Allah, we sincerely beseech you, strengthen our beliefs according to the creed of *Ahlus* Sunnah wal-Jamaa'ah, and protect us from deeds and 'ageedah that are astray such as the extreme Shee'is, Qadiyani, and other ideologies.

O Allah, open up our hearts in fulfilling the five daily prayers, performing zakaat, and other obligations. Bless those that have fulfilled their zakaat and loving the fugaraa' and masaakin, and those that have

made waqfand gave up their wealth for Tabung Amanah Pembangunan Islam Selangor (Islamic Development Trust Fund of Selangor) with continuous reward until the Hereafter.

### Allah, increase and widen the rizg of those that made wagf from their wealth with perpetual rewards until the Last Day.
