#### HEARI



I remind myself and all of us to always strive in increasing our taqwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala. Taqwa can be increased by fulfilling all of

Commands and avoiding all of His prohibitions. May we all become among His slaves whom are granted His blessings and love, as well as His protection, Subhaanahu Wata 'aala.

On this blessed Friday, let us internalize upon the *khutbah* entitled: "*Hardened Heart*."

Rasulullah عليه وسلم is solely the best teacher for his ummah, and he has taught and reminded us from the biggest matters to the small ones, in our purview. With the topic of this week's khutbah,

I would like to sincerely remind all of us upon the words of Rasulullah عليه وسلم that serves as the very foundation for mankind.

Narrated an-Nu'maan ibn Basheer radiy Allaahu 'anh: Rasulullah عليه وسلم said:

"... Verily, there is a piece of flesh in the body, if it is healthy, the whole body is healthy, and if it is corrupt, the whole body is corrupt. Verily, it is the heart."

(al-Bukhaari and Muslim)

Based on this hadeeth, it is evident to us that the heart has a deep impact upon any living body, for if such flesh is safeguarded, then the whole body is sound. On the contrary, if otherwise,

then evil indeed will be the end result. Therefore, the Muslim must never take lightly upon this very message from Rasulullah عليه وسلم in protecting one's heart and conscience.

The Muslims scholars have discussed at length regarding matters pertaining to hardened hearts and its causes. Al-Imaam ibn al-Qayyim rahimahullaah mentioned in

#### his work Badaa'i' al-Fawaa'id:

"When the eyes are dried up due to not shedding tears out of the fear of Allah, then know that indeed those dry eyes are due to the

hardening of the heart. The most distant heart from Allah is the heart which is hardened."

Based on these words, it is in harmony with the words of Rasulullah عليه وسلم regarding

the characteristics that is most beloved to Allah Himself. 'A'ishah radiyAllaahu 'anha reported that Rasulullah عليه وسلم said:

## "... Verily Allah loves gentleness in every matter."

(al-Bukhaari, Muslim, at-Tirmidhi)

From this hadeeth, it is understood to us that the vast majority of hardened hearts are in opposition to matters that are liked by Allah. And without realizing, we are further distancing away from

# Allah due to our own negligence in protecting the heart.

There are too many factors that harden the hearts of mankind, not safeguarding the relationship with Allah, that one is always committing disobedience.

Indeed, it is one of the main reasons regarding the change upon the heart. Have we not listened to the words of Rasulullah عليه وسلم regarding those black spots on the heart?

Al-Imaam at-Tirmidhi rahimahullaah collected a hadeeth narrated by Abu Hurayrah radiyAllaahu 'anh, that Rasulullah عليه وسلم said:

"When the believer commits sin, a black spot appears on his heart. If he repents and gives up that sin and seeks forgiveness, his heart will be polished. But if (the sin) increases,

(the black spot) increases. That is the Raan that Allah mentions in His Book: "Nay! But on their hearts is the Raan (covering of sins and evil deeds) which they used to earn. [83:14]""

Indeed, it is very clear with the story depicted in this hadeeth. For every sins committed that are not followed by tawbaah, it will cause our hearts to become totally covered by the black

spots, ultimately becoming pitch dark.

There are many acts of disobedience that will ultimately cause the hardening of the heart. Among them, other than

sinning and surrendering to the desire, is too much laughing, consuming food from unlawful sources, going overboard in discussing non-beneficial matters, not reciting

al-Qur'an, not constantly making dhikr of Allah, surrounded by those having bad akhlaaq, deficient in their religious practice, and many more. Everything that causes us to become

negligent to Allah will only indirectly increase in the hardening of the heart. Among the ways to soften our hearts is by visiting the graveyard as it was narrated by Anas ibn Maalik

radiyAllaahu 'anh that Pasulullah عليه وسلم said:

"... I forbade you to visit the graves then it appeared to me that they soften the heart, bring tears to the eyes, and remind one of the

# Hereafter. Therefore, visit them, but do not say reprehensible things!"

(al-Haakim and Ahmad)

### In addition, other 'ibaadah that can soften one's heart are:

- 1. Always reciting al-Qur'an with full internalization.
- 2. Increasing one's 'ibaadah and dhikr of Allah.

3. Always remembering death, visiting the sick, and following the janaazah to the grave. 4. Always consuming halaal food.

- 5. Always listening to religious lectures and advice.
- 6. Always be mindful on the severity of the Last Day, so that we will be prepared to stand before Allah Subhaanahu Wata 'aala.

7. Always supplicating to Allah to soften our hearts so that it will be free from evil and dirty traits.

Human actions truly originate from the heart, so if the heart is spared from evil and vile characteristics, then it will manifest actions that are Islamic and far from disobeying Allah

Subhaanahu Wata 'aala. It behooves us to always supplicate so that we are granted soft hearts, and with soft hearts, Allah bestows good upon us.

Today, I remind myself and implore all of us to not let our hearts become like the Jews, humiliated and cursed because of their hardened hearts. Hence, they will forever remain in falsehood

and rebuked by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala. "Then why, when Our punishment came to them, did they not humble themselves? But their hearts became hardened,

## and Satan made attractive to them that which they were doing."

(al-An'am 6:43)

بَارَكَ اللهُ لِي وَلَكُمْ فِي الْقُرْآنِ الْعَظِيْمِ وَنَفَعَنِي وَإِيَّاكُمْ بِمَا فِيْهِ مِنَ الأَبَاتِ وَالذُّكْرِ الْحَكِيْمِ وَتَقَبَّلَ مِنِّي وَمِنْكُمْ تِلاوَتَهُ إِنَّهُ هُوَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيمُ. أَقُولُ قُولِيْ هَذَا وَأَسْتَغُورُ اللهَ الْعَظِيْمَ لِي وَلَكُمْ وَلِسَائِر الْمُسْلِمِيْنَ وَالْمُسْلِمَاتِ وَالْمُؤْمِنِيْنَ وَالْمُؤْمِنَاتِ الأُحيَاءِ مِنْهُمْ وَالْأَمُواتُ فَاسْتَغْفِرُوهُ إِنَّهُ هُوَ الْغَفُورُ الرَّحِيْمُ .

Once again, I would like to remind all of us that Islam teach its adherents to remain moderate in all actions and deeds. At the same time, the Muslims are to avoid any form of extremism in which its

consequences will only disrupt the harmony, unity, and security of the Muslim ummah and our nation. Extremism will only give negative impression upon the nobility and holiness of al-Islam. On the contrary, the Muslim

ummah must inculcate noble akhlaaq, having utmost personality and attitude as true Muslims so that the world will know that Rasulullah (عليه وسلم) was sent down as a messenger, and Islam that was revealed is mercy

## for the entire nation and universe.

O Allah, You are the Lord that is All Mighty, we are grateful to You for having bestowed upon us rahmah and ni'mah, that we are able to continue the effort in empowering the Muslim ummah especially in Selangor, as an

advanced state, prosperous, and providing welfare.

Hence, we sincerely beseech you, O Allah, strengthen our imaan, accept our deeds, strengthen our unity, increase our rizg, enrich us with

beneficial knowledge, cultivate our soul with good mannerisms, return us to the path that you are pleased with, protect us from disasters and your severe trials, so that our nation will become more peaceful and filled with blessings.

O Allah, we sincerely beseech you, strengthen our beliefs according to the creed of Ahlus Sunnah wal-Jamaa'ah, and protect us from deeds and 'ageedah that are astray such as the extreme Shee'is, Qadiyani, and other ideologies.

O Allah, open up our hearts in fulfilling the five daily prayers, performing zakaat, and other obligations. Bless those that have fulfilled their zakaat and loving the fugaraa' and masaakin, and those that have

made waqf and gave up their wealth for Tabung Amanah Pembangunan Islam Selangor (Islamic Development Trust Fund of Selangor) with continuous reward until the Hereafter.

O Allah, increase and widen the rizg of those that made wagf from their wealth with perpetual rewards until the Last Day.
