The topic of today's khutbah is: "Embracing Independence According To The Islamic Perspective."

Alhamdulillaah, today citizens of Malaysia rejoice and express their gratefulness to Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala upon the blessings of Independence that they had

gained 58 years ago. Realize or not, the colonialists whether the British, Dutch, Japanese, Portuguese, and even the communists had militarily left our nation. They all had returned to their nations after four centuries of profiteering from this nation's resources while at the same time bringing in various culture, lifestyle, and beliefs. They had returned after having to confront the

continuous struggle by the natives of this land who wanted to free this nation and their beloved homeland. Our nation's history is carved with names of great freedom fighters throughout

the colonial era of this land. Beginning with Tun Perak during the Malaccan period to Raja Haji in Selangor, Tuan Guru Haji Abdul Rahman Limbung in Terengganu, Mat Kilau in

Pahang, Mat Saleh in Sarawak, Tuan Guru Haji Hasan Monas (better known as Tok Janggut) in Kelantan, and many other great warriors. Verily, they formed the chain that would link up

to the struggle of Rasulullah and his Companions عليه وسلم whom had sacrificed their lives and wealth in defending the Islamic state in Madinah and freeing Holy Makkah al-Mukarramah.

They fought with perseverance, patience, and diligence. They were not afraid with the full arsenal of weapons possessed by the colonialists. They were warriors that did not fear

death for they had full certainty upon the promise of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala mentioned in al-Qur'an:

"And never think of those who have been killed in the cause of Allah as dead. Rather, they are alive with their Lord, receiving provision."

(Aal-'Imraan 3:169)

After half century since our nation has attained Independence, is such struggle for Independence no longer necessary? Has our nation achieved Independence in all aspects of lives? Indeed, this struggle is a struggle that is continuous for a lifetime. For us living in post-Independence era, we must be intelligent in continuing and strategizing the struggle

in a format that is truly beneficial to the nation and its citizen.

Wading through an era that is robust with information, the Malaysian citizens, especially the Muslims,

must remain independent and free from ignorance. Malaysians especially the Muslims must strive to attain beneficial knowledge, for knowledge is something that will always thrive at a rapid

pace. The development of knowledge and technology should be dominated by the Muslim ummah. If the Muslims are slow and inattentive, then others

would advance and dominate. Hence, the Muslims will continue to become buyers and consumers, exposed to the risk of manipulation and fraud by the capitalists.

Therefore, the Muslim ummah must be diligent in mastering knowledge for it is obligated upon every Muslim. It was narrated from Anas ibn Maalik radiyAllaahu'anh that

Rasulullah صلى الله said: "Seeking knowledge is a duty upon every Muslim..." (ibn Maajah: da'eef with sound meaning)

In a time that is full of challenges, the Muslims should free themselves from any deviant teachings and ideologies that are on the rise in this country. Nowadays, we find many sects that are

spreading heretical beliefs and contradicting the teachings of Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa'ah becoming bold in spreading their teachings openly. Even more unfortunate is that many

Muslims would become affected by them, including those that are highly educated and professionals. It is as if their 'ageedah and thoughts have been colonized by ideologies that

attempts to deviate them from the True Path. In safeguarding authentic Islamic teachings, programs that solidify the 'ageedah and religious creed should be further emphasized at all

levels beginning from the early age. We are an ummah (nation) that firmly clings upon and guided by al-Qur'an and as-Sunnah. Let us strictly follow the true authentic

teachings of Islam. Let us adhere to the guidance given by Rasulullah عليه وسلم and also the scholars who continued his da'wah efforts عليه وسلم There is absolutely no need for us to take guidance from

than Islam. Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala mentions in al-Qur'an: "And, [moreover], this is My path, which is straight, so follow it; and do not follow [other] ways,

for you will be separated from His way. This has He instructed you that you may become righteous." (al-An'aam 6:153) The freedom that we should struggle for in today's world is to embrace Independence by improving our akhlaaq and social lives. Merdeka (freedom) in akhlaaq does not mean to liberate oneself

from the religious ties and guidance. Instead, it is to free oneself from getting shackled by indecency, hedonistic culture, wandering aimlessly, fanaticism with lifestyles

that deviates from Islamic teachings, and many other negative behaviors. The Muslims must realize that Islam is the true religion that is pleasing to Allah. There is no need to emulate

the culture of those that are not based upon Divine revelation. For this, I implore upon everyone, especially the organizers of entertainment events, to not engrain cultures that are

incompatible with the local culture here. Abu Hurayrah radiyAllaahu 'anh reported: Rasulullah صلى الله Said:

"The most complete of the believers in faith, is the one with the best character among them. And the best of you are those who are best to your women." (at-Tirmidhi: hasan) In the midst of the Muslim ummah's enthusiasm to passionately strive in returning to the true Islamic teachings, let they not become ensnared by extremism that is not based upon the Shara'. Islam is a religion of prosperity and peacefulness, truly emphasizing upon harmony and prosperous living. There is no need for us to choose ways and methods of

struggle that will only inflict harm greater than benefit, damages greater than progress, and chaos that are greater than tranquility. Nabi صلى الله has manifested a clever approach with full

wisdom in his da'wah efforts that he would always capture the attention of mankind to get themselves closer to this heavenly religion. Similarly with his Companions radiyAllaahu 'anhum

ajma'een. Even though they would bring the military to their destinations, they would never coerce the locals to embrace Islam. It is enough with the noble akhlaaq that they displayed

and utterances from their mouth and tongue, causing the locals to become attracted to Islam, and in the end they would embrace Islam and become good Muslims.

Among lessons that can be derived today are: 1- The Muslim ummah must internalize the full concept of Independence that was bestowed by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala,

by becoming closer to Allah and practicing Islam in its entirety.

2- The Muslim ummah must always free themselves from ignorance, hedonism, deviant teachings,

extremism, and many more. 3- The Muslim ummah are reminded that it is inappropriate to commemorate Independence Day with entertainment parties, but instead it should

be filled with programs that will increase the awareness, realization, and gratefulness to Allah for the blessings of freedom attained.

"[And they are] those who, if We give them authority in the land, establish prayer and give zakaah and enjoin what is right and forbid what

is wrong. And to Allah belongs the outcome of [all] matters." (al-Hajj 22:41)

ummah must inculcate noble akhlaaq, having utmost personality and attitude as true Muslims so that the world will know that Rasulullah (عليه وسلم) was sent down as a messenger, and Islam that was revealed is mercy

for the entire nation and universe.

O Allah, You are the Lord that is All Mighty, we are grateful to You for having bestowed upon us rahmah and ni'mah, that we are able to continue the effort in empowering the Muslim ummah especially in Selangor, as an

advanced state, prosperous, and providing welfare.

Hence, we sincerely beseech you, O Allah, strengthen our imaan, accept our deeds, strengthen our unity, increase our rizq, enrich us

beneficial knowledge, cultivate our soul with good mannerisms, return us to the path that you are pleased with, protect us from disasters and your severe trials, so that our nation will become more peaceful and filled with blessings.

O Allah, we sincerely beseech you, strengthen our beliefs according to the creed of Ahlus Sunnah wal-Jamaa'ah, and protect us from deeds and 'ageedah that are astray such as the extreme Shee'is, Qadiyani, and other ideologies.

O Allah, open up our hearts in fulfilling the five daily prayers, performing zakaat, and other obligations. Bless those that have fulfilled their zakaat and loving the fugaraa' and masaakin, and those that have
