



THE PILLAR OF RELIGION



Let us be grateful to Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala for all the bounties that He had bestowed upon us by increasing our taqwa of Allah, by fulfilling all of

Commands and avoiding all of His prohibitions. May we become among the successful ones in this world and the Hereafter.

In these blessed moments, let us render full attention and internalize upon a khutbah entitled "Salaah: The Pillar Of Religion"

Salaah (prayer) is waajib (obligatory) upon every Muslim individual. It is an obligation that was commanded by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala almost 1500 years ago.

It was legislated five years before the Hijrah. Salaah is a major obligation in Islam. It was due to the great importance of salaah that Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala had raised up

صلىالله Prophet Muhammad during the night of Mi'raaj to decree the legislation Himself without the intermediation of an angel just like in other 'ibaadaat. The obligation of salaah

remains and it is not removed from anyone who is a mukallaf (accountable for religious duties) for as long as he or she is still breathing and sane. Salaah was originally

legislated during the Israa' and Mi'raaj at 50 times a day, but then reduced by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala to only five times per day, with its rewards maintained being equivalent

to 50 prayers. Anas ibn Maalik radiy Allaahu'anh narrated: "On the Night of Israa', fifty prayers were made obligatory upon the Prophet (صلى الله عليه وسلم). Then it

decreased until it was made five. Then it was called out: 'O Muhammad! Indeed My Word does not change; these five prayers will be recorded for you as fifty""

(hadeeth Qudsi collected by at-Tirmidhi: saheeh) The obligation of five daily prayers was repeatedly mentioned in al-Qur'an. Among them is this verse: "And establish prayer and give zakaah and bow with those who bow [in worship

and obedience]" (al-Baqarah 2:43)

Take heed, for the one who abandons salaah will be inflicted with severe punishment or torment from Allah Subhaanahu

Wata'aala even in this world, at the time of death, in the grave, and in the Hereafter. The punishment in this world is that Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala will remove blessings from such

person's provision and signs of righteousness will be removed from the face. The torment when the soul is taken out of the body is the extreme feeling of thirst and pain. In the torment of the

grave, one would not be able to answer the questionings by the angels Munkar and Nakeer, hence the grave becomes narrow and dark. In the punishment of the Hereafter, the bad deeds will

outweigh the good deeds, incurring the Wrath of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala and such person will be sent to the Hellfire. Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala mentions in al-Qur'an:

"[And asking them], "What put you into Sagar?" They will say, "We were not of those who prayed""

(al-Muddaththir 74:42-43)

Take heed, for salaah is one of the five pillars of Islam. Hence one's Islam will not be complete unless all of its pillars are fulfilled, especially the shahaadah (testimony) and salaah.

As mentioned in the hadeeth of 'Abdullah ibn **'Umar** radiyAllaahu`anhuma whom reported: I heard the Messenger of Allah (صلى الله عليه وسلم) say, "Islam has been built on five [pillars]:

testifying that there is no deity worthy of worship except Allah and that Muhammad is the Messenger of Allah, establishing the salaah (prayer), paying the zakaat

(obligatory charity), making the hajj (pilgrimage) to the House, and fasting in Ramadaan"

(al-Bukhaari and Muslim)

Know that the legislated five daily prayers decreed by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala is an obligation that must be fulfilled by every Muslim individual, for salaah is the pillar or foundation of Islam. Which means that Islam can only be upheld within a person by performing the 'ibaadah of salaah and one's Islam vanishes when salaah is abandoned.

In addition, it must be known and internalized that salaah is a very significant 'ibaadah in a Muslim's daily life. Hence, fortunate and secured are those that performed their salaah

khushoo' (full devotion) and perfection. What a loss for those who abandoned their salaah for it is the first deed that will be judged by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala in the Hereafter and it will be

the crucial determinant for the perfection and acceptance of other deeds. Abu Hurayrah radiy Allaahu`anh reported: Rasulullah صلى الله Said:

"The first matter that the slave will be brought to account for on the Day of Judgment is the prayer. If it is sound, then the rest of his deeds will be sound.

And if it is incomplete, then the rest of his deeds will be incomplete"

(at-Tirmidhi, an-Nasaa'i, at-Tabaraani: saheeh)

Verily, the 'ibaadah of salaah that was obligated by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala upon us is solely for our own good. Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala will not gain from the salaah that

we perform, or will Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala lose when Muslims abandon them. It is only mankind themselves that would lose out when neglecting their salaah.

Therefore, salaah that is performed with sincerity, khushoo', perfection, and purely seeking the pleasure of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala, it will produce wisdom to its doer. Among

the hikmah are: 1. The 'ibaadah of salaah will remind the slave and take him closer to his Creator, Rabb al-Jaleel. Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala mentions in

al-Qur'an: "Indeed, I am Allah. There is no deity except Me, so worship Me and establish prayer for My remembrance" (Ta-Ha 20:14) 2- The five daily salawaat will expiate the minor sins. Abu Hurayrah radiy Allaahu'anh reported: Rasulullah عليه وسلم said:

"Five prayers and from one Friday prayer to (the

next) Friday prayer is an expiation (of the sins committed in between their intervals) if major sins are not committed" (Muslim)

3- Salaah prevents evil and wicked deeds. Through salaah, one will feel the greatness, grandeur, and glory of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala, as well as fearing and terrified from His Wrath,

which serves as deterrent from committing evil and wickedness. As Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala mentions in al-Qur'an: "...and establish prayer. Indeed, prayer prohibits

immorality and wrongdoing.."

(al-'Ankaboot 29:45)

4- Salaah calms the soul. Those performing salaah, their hearts will feel the tranquil and calmness. Thus, they will be able to regulate their level of stress and depression.

It is as Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala has explained in al-Qur'an: "Indeed, mankind was created anxious: When evil touches him, impatient, And when good touches

him, withholding of it], Except the observers of prayer -Those who are constant in their prayer" (al-Ma'aarij 70:19-23)

5- Salaah will bring success, blessings, and blissfulness in life. Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala mentions in al-Qur'an: "Certainly will the believers have succeeded:

"Certainly will the believers have succeeded: They who are during their prayer humbly submissive" (al-Mu'minoon 23:1-2)

The lessons and contemplations that we can gain from today's khutbah are:

1- The Muslim ummah must place great importance to perform their salaah without any excuse.

2- We must always ensure that our salaah are performed with perfection and khushoo'.

3- We must always ensure that our family members are obedient and observant in performing their salaah on time.

4- The Muslims should not abandon their salaah for it will only incur the Wrath of Allah and severely punished in the Hellfire of Sagar.

"Maintain with care the [obligatory] prayers and [in particular] the middle prayer and stand before Allah, devoutly obedient" (al-Baqarah 2:238) بَارَكَ اللهُ لِيْ وَلَكُمْ فِي الْقُرْآنِ الْعَظِيْمِ وَنَفَعنِي وَإِيَّاكُمْ بِمَا فِيْهِ مِنَ الأَيَاتِ وَالذُّكْرِ الْحَكِيْم وَتَقْبَلَ مِنِّي وَمِنْكُمْ تِلاوَتُهُ إِنَّهُ هُوَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيْمُ. أَقُولُ قُولِيْ هَذَا وَأَسْتَغُورُ اللهَ الْعَظِيْمَ لِيْ وَلَكُمْ وَلِسَائِرِ الْمُسْلِمِيْنَ وَالْمُسْلِمَاتِ وَالْمُؤْمِنِيْنَ وَالْمُؤْمِنَاتِ الْأَحْبَاعِ مِنْهُمْ وَالأَمْوَاتِ فَاسْتَغْفِرُوْهُ إِنَّهُ هُوَ الْغَفُورُ الرَّحِيْمُ

Once again, I would like to remind all of us that Islam teach its adherents to remain moderate in all actions and deeds. At the same time, the Muslims are to avoid any form of extremism in which its

consequences will only disrupt the harmony, unity, and security of the Muslim ummah and our nation. Extremism will only give negative impression upon the nobility and holiness of al-Islam. On the contrary, the Muslim

ummah must inculcate noble akhlaaq, having utmost personality and attitude as true Muslims so that the world will know that Rasulullah (عليه وسلم) was sent down as a messenger, and Islam that was revealed is

for the entire nation and universe.

O Allah, You are the Lord that is All Mighty, we are grateful to You for having bestowed upon us rahmah and ni'mah, that we are able to continue the effort in empowering the Muslim ummah especially in Selangor, as an

advanced state, prosperous, and providing welfare. Hence, we sincerely beseech you, O Allah, strengthen our imaan, accept our deeds, strengthen our unity, increase our rizq, enrich us

beneficial knowledge, cultivate our soul with good mannerisms, return us to the path that you are pleased with, protect us from disasters and your severe trials, so that our nation will become more peaceful and filled with blessings.

O Allah, we sincerely beseech you, strengthen our beliefs according to the creed of Ahlus Sunnah wal-Jamaa'ah, and protect us from deeds and 'ageedah that are astray such as the extreme Shee'is, Qadiyani, and other ideologies.

O Allah, open up our hearts in fulfilling the five daily prayers, performing zakaat, and other obligations. Bless those that have fulfilled their zakaat and loving the fugaraa' and masaakin, and those that have

made wagfand gave up their wealth for Tabung Amanah Pembangunan Islam Selangor (Islamic **Development Trust Fund of** Selangor) with continuous reward until the Hereafter.

O Allah, increase and widen the rizg of those that made waqf from their wealth with perpetual rewards until the Last Day.
