Subhaanahu Wata'aala is the
ultimate key in attaining
success in this world and
the Hereafter.**

**In conjunction with the 70th
birthday of His Royal**

**Highness the Sultan of
Selangor, the khutbah
today is entitled**

***“The Ruler: The Head
Of Religious Affairs Of
The State”***

**Indeed, the monarchy plays
a vital role in our homeland.**

**According to history, since
the arrival of Islam in the
Nusantara (Malay
Archipelago), the role
undertaken by the sultan**

became tremendously significant. His Royal Highness not only acts as the protector of the people but also plays a role in the spread of Islam to various provinces throughout the

Nusantara!

Indeed, the greatness of the sultans or rulers from the early Islamic kingdom was truly impressive. There were sultans in the Nusantara that possessed greatness in terms

of *taqwa* of Allah and provincial governing skills. The wisdom of the *du'aat* (callers to Islam) had enabled *imaan* to penetrate into the soul of the rulers.

**How were the *du'aat* able to
get the rulers and citizens to
embrace Islam back then?**

Among their methods were:

**1. To initiate their *da'wah* to
the rulers directly as it was
done by Mawlanā ‘Abdul**

'Azeez to Parameswara.

**2. Then, giving da'wah to the
princes and members of the
royal family such as the
conversion of Pangeran
Cakrabuana, the son (prince)
of Raja Pajajaran who was**

a

Hindu.

3. Further, the du'aat themselves established new Islamic government, such as Sultan Syariful Hashim establishing the Sulu government.

4. The wisdom of “wali songo” scholars in their success of conveying *da’wah* to the rulers in their respective states.

After the conversion of the rulers, the masses would

**then follow suit in
embracing Islam. It has
become the norm of the
society of that time to have
full-undivided loyalty to
their rulers. With that, it
was easy for the masses to**

embrace Islam one their ruler accepts Islam.

Then, the title of the ruler (king) gets changed to “sultan”. The Muslim scholars were then appointed by the sultan as his advisors,

**and they were always close
with the sultan. In result, it
gave rise to a generation of
sultans having great
personalities and
righteousness in ruling their
kingdom according to the**

Sharee'ah.

**Looking back into history,
the Muslim *ummah* takes
great pride in the history
of its righteous leaders. If
we are to ask the Syrians
regarding Sultan**

**Nooruddeen az-Zinki,
definitely they will recognize
him and know the history of
that that prominent sultan.
Similar with the history of
Sultan Salaahuddeen al-
Ayyoobi for the Egyptians,**

**Sultan Muhammad al-Fateh
for the Turks, so on and so
forth, where Muslim
societies in other nations
would preserve the history
of their righteous rulers.**

**Many of us do not realize
that there**

were righteous sultans in the provinces of the Nusantara.

A book titled “*Righteous Sultans In The Nusantara*”

authored by Hasanuddin

Yusof listed 24 righteous

sultans that had once ruled

Islamic governments in the Nusantara. They had rendered invaluable service to the society. Some of them were actually catalysts in the spread of *da'wah* work. Some of them became pillars

of strength in fighting off
the efforts and wicked ploy
of Western colonialists. It
was due to their noble
efforts and service that the
‘aqeedah of the Muslims in
the Nusantara was able to
be

**preserved until today, even
though this region was
colonized for more than
500 years. For that, they
will be greatly rewarded as
promised by Allah
*Subhaanahu Wata'aala, as***

mentioned in al-Qur'an:

**“Whoever does
righteousness, whether
male or female, while he is
a believer - We will surely
cause him to live a good
life, and We will surely give**

**them their reward [in
the Hereafter]
according to the best
of what they used to
do”**

(an-Nahl 16:97)

**According to historical facts,
among the eminent sultan
in the state of Selangor is
Sultan Sulayman Shah, who
was the fifth Sultan of
Selangor. He was a pious
sultan and truly loved the**

scholars. He would always seek the view and advice from the scholars in every matters pertaining to state administration and efforts in spreading Islam.

His love for the scholars
signified his love for Nabi
Muhammad ﷺ for the
scholars are the inheritors of
the prophets. As it was
narrated by Abu ad-Dardaa'
radiyAllaahu'anhu that

Rasulullah ﷺ said:

“...The learned are the heirs of the Prophets who bequeath neither dinar nor dirham but only that of knowledge; and he who acquires it, has in fact

acquired an abundant portion”

(Abu Dawood: saheeh)

Sultan Sulayman Shah had great concerns about the development of Islam in

Selangor. He had actually built two mosques, namely one in Jugra that was named Masjid Sultan Alaeddin and another one in Klang named Masjid Sultan Sulayman, in providing ease and comfort

for the Muslims to perform their prayers. Sultan Sulayman Shah also would frequently deliver the Friday *khutbah*, the ‘Eidulfitr and ‘Eiduladha khutbah at various mosques in Selangor

**especially at Sultan
Alaeddin Royal Mosque.
Due to his deep interest
in Islamic sciences, he
even wrote a few Islamic
books himself.**

In strengthening the creed of
Ahl as-Sunnah wal-Jamaa'ah,
he authored his famous
works, among them "*Pohon*
Agama Bahagian Rukun
Iman" (The Tree Of
Religion, The Chapter On

The Articles Of Faith) and
a book on tawheed titled
*“Melatih Kanak-Kanak
Lelaki Dan Perempuan
Agama Islam”* (Training
The Boys And Girls About
Islam).

**This book was once used as
a textbook in the Islamic
schools in Selangor. Sultan
Sulayman Shah had also
produced several religious
poetry that are interesting,
providing both guidelines**

and lessons for his subjects. His writings proved that he was a sultan who had mastered a high level of religious knowledge. He had passed away on the 31st of May, 1938 at the age of 72,

after ruling the state for 40 years. The demise of this “people-oriented” (*berjiwa rakyat*) sultan was mourned by all walks of life of that time.

**Verily, the contributions of
the Malay Rulers to the
religion, people, and nation
are truly impressive to the
citizens. They would deem
that the rank that they held
is not for boasting and
pride,**

**but instead it is a great
amaanah and responsibility
with daunting challenges.
The higher the leadership
they assume, the greater
the responsibility to be
shouldered.**

Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala
calls upon the Muslims to
obey their ruler for the
rulers would bear a very
heavy burden in ensuring
the well being of the
society and nation.

**Especially in protecting the
holiness of the Islam.**

**Therefore, we as citizens
should obey the sultans, be
truly appreciative of their
contributions and having
affection for their sacrifices,**

as Allah Subhaanahu
Wata'aala mentions in al-
Qur'an:

**“O you who have believed,
obey Allah and obey the
Messenger and those in
authority among you. And if
you disagree**

**over anything, refer it to
Allah and the Messenger,
if you should believe in
Allah and the Last Day.
That is the best [way] and
best in result.”**

(an-Nisaa' 4:59)

**As citizens that cling upon
the creed of *Ahl as-Sunnah*
wal-Jamaa'ah, we should
obey all of the sultan's
commands for as long as
they are good and not
contradicting the *Sharee'ah*.**

**Alhamdulillaah, today we are
truly grateful to Allah
Subhaanahu Wata'aala for our
ruler, His Royal Highness
Sultan Idris Shah ibni al-
Marhum Sultan
Salaahuddeen 'Abdul 'Azeez**

Shah al-Haj, the Sultan of Selangor Darul Ehsan, is a ruler that is people-oriented (*berjiwa rakyat*). His Royal Highness is always concerned with the development and well being

of the masses. He is never tired of asking the masses to unite, always avoiding conflicts, discord, and slander, so that the state of Selangor will be at peace and tranquil. In addition, His

**Royal Highness would
always address the
masses to reject all forms
of deviant teachings and
sects that truly contradict
the creed of *Ahl as-Sunnah*
*wal-Jamaa'ah.***

Under his auspice as the head of religion, the symbols of Islam have increasingly shined, and the public awareness on the importance of religious knowledge has tremendously enhanced.

For example, zakaat collection has been increasing from year to year. Similarly with the public awareness in making waqf (endowment) including in the form of cash, has been

**well received by the masses.
Mosques and suraus have
been beautifully constructed
and Islamic schools have
received encouraging
responses whether at the
primary or secondary level.**

Therefore, we should positively welcome every recommendation made by His Royal Highness who would always call for the strengthening of brotherhood, enhancing the

unity, and avoiding divisions. Furthermore, mosques are to be made as a place of worship, not as a platform in causing problems or discord among Muslims.

The existing cordial relationship between the monarchy and the citizens must be preserved and defended from any challenges and *fitnah* so that the symbols of Islam will

**continue to flourish, the
dignity of the Muslims
safeguarded, protected,
and the state will
remain peaceful and
prosperous.**

In concluding this *khutbah*,
let us increase our
righteous deeds towards
that which is pleasing to
Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala
by emphasizing on these
matters:

1. We should always obey the commands of Allah and His Messenger. Next, we should always obey the rulers and just leaders in fulfilling the responsibility with full amaanah.

2. We should always remain grateful for the countless bounties from Allah that we are enjoying now, by increasing our *taqwa* and righteous deeds.

**3. The Muslims must strive
to inculcate positive
thoughts upon others and
rid off any prejudice and
slander.**

**4. Everyone in this state
should remain united in
defending the monarch's**

**status as the head of
religious affairs, so that by
the Will of Allah, Islam
will be upheld and the
dignity of the Muslims will
always be safeguarded
and protected.**

**“Say, “O Allah, Owner of
Sovereignty, You give
sovereignty to whom You
will and You take
sovereignty away from
whom You will. You honor
whom You will and You**

**humble whom You will. In
Your hand is [all] good.
Indeed, You are over all
things competent””**

(Aal-'Imraan 3:26)

ummah must inculcate noble akhlaaq, having utmost personality and attitude as true Muslims so that the world will know that Rasulullah (صلی اللہ علیہ وسلم) was sent down as a messenger, and Islam that was revealed is mercy

**for the entire nation and
universe.**

**O Allah, You are the Lord that
is All Mighty, we are grateful
to You for having bestowed
upon us *rahmah* and *ni'mah*,
that we are able to continue
the effort in empowering the
Muslim *ummah* especially in
Selangor, as an**

**advanced state, prosperous,
and providing welfare.**

**Hence, we sincerely beseech
you, O Allah, strengthen our
imaan, accept our deeds,
strengthen our unity,
increase our *rizq*, enrich us
with**

**beneficial knowledge,
cultivate our soul with good
mannerisms, return us to the
path that you are pleased
with, protect us from disasters
and your severe trials, so that
our nation will become more
peaceful and filled with
blessings.**
