*khutbah* entitled

***"Faithful Youth: Heir To  
The Nation's Future"***



**Lately, we have been fed with  
unpleasant news regarding  
our young generation.**

**Numerous cases of criminal  
misconduct, *Sharee'ah-*  
related crime, disciplinary  
and etiquette**

**problems are often linked to them. Such predicament would definitely cause worry and anger amongst parents nowadays. The young generation today is a reflection of the nation's**

**future. According to  
Professor Dr Yoosuf al-  
Qaradaawi, a renowned and  
well-respected contemporary  
Muslim scholar and thinker,  
he said:**

*“If we want to see the outlook of the nation in the future, then look at the young generation of today. If the youngsters of today are from among those having good akhlaaq and mannerism,*

*then certainly our nation in  
the future will be one that is  
peaceful and prosperous*

*“baldatun tayyibatun wa  
rabbun ghafoor” (a good  
land and a forgiving Lord).*

*But if it is the opposite,  
then*

*be prepared to face the evil  
that is to come”*

A famous Egyptian poet and  
thinker, Shaykh Ahmad  
Shawki, had once uttered:

*“Verily a nation is strong and  
great due to its akhlaaq.*



*If their akhlaaq is corrupted, then the nation will disappear and vanish”*



**In our effort to find the  
*manhaj* (methodology) to  
build and develop the youth  
of today, it necessitates  
earnest and great attention  
from all parties, whether the  
government or citizens.**

**However, let not such effort remain as “*ala kadar*” (just enough), only doing the bare minimum (complacent) or on seasonal basis.**



Indeed, the role and responsibility of the youth today is vital and important in spurring the growth of the nation, people, and religious ideals. The role of the youth today is not just to build

**their career or pursuing activities to fill up their leisure time or as hobby, but young people must also partake in contributing ideas, time, and energy towards human capital development**

unto becoming a nation that is  
respected at the world stage.

The Muslim youth today  
should not just become  
spectators or reserves, instead  
always remain prepared to  
become key

**players in driving the *ummah* to lead human civilization and becoming the exemplary nation, especially at a time where the image of Islam is depicted in the very worst of form. The bleak images of**

**the face of Islam today must  
be corrected through the  
strength of knowledge,  
*imaan, akhlaaq*, personal  
character, intellect, economy,  
thoughts, and culture of  
today's young generation.**

The role of the young generation truly shined throughout the history of mankind itself. It was the youth that would serve as the precursor to any revival movement, and as movers in

**bringing about changes within  
the masses. In the history of  
Islam, from its early days in  
Makkah to its spread in  
Madeenah, it was the youth  
that had played key roles with  
the**

remaining loyal in  
striving and performing

*jihad* to uphold the

*kalimah* of Allah on this  
earth.



Ponder upon the great names  
of ‘Ali, ‘Uthmaan, ‘Abdur  
Rahmaan ibn ‘Awf, ibn  
Zubayr, ibn ‘Abbaas, and  
many other Companions who  
were leading players and  
driving force in the

nurturing of the Islamic civilization. History had also witnessed the agility of Usaamah bin Zayd even at the tender age of 18, but was able to lead an army to fight the Romans. Similarly with

**the greatness of Muhammad  
al-Faateh whom conquered  
Istanbul (Constantinople)  
though he was only 21 years  
old.**



In addition, the story of *as-haab ul-ukhdoode*, where a boy had firmly protected his ‘*aqeedah* by rejecting the threats of the king’s magician in acknowledging that the king is God.

Several attempts were made to assassinate the boy such as pushing him off the cliff and throwing him into the sea, but they were all unsuccessful. Until the boy himself suggested for a

skilled archer to be brought,  
on the condition that the  
archer will utter out loud  
*“Bismillaahi bi rabbil  
ghulaam”* (in the name of  
Allah, the Lord of the boy)  
upon releasing the arrow.

**Only then, the boy died.  
Upon witnessing this, those  
that had gathered testified,  
“We believe in the Lord of  
the boy.”**



**Another youth that had contributed immensely throughout history is none other than Mus‘ab ibn ‘Umayr *radiyAllaahu‘anh*. He hailed from a noble Arab lineage, having high stature,**

**wealth, and tremendously  
adored by Arab girls. He was  
severely forbidden from  
coming close to Prophet  
Muhammad ﷺ, and  
prohibited from crossing  
path with Prophet**

**Muhammad ﷺ. Such prohibition only made Mus'ab yearn to know more about the Prophet. Allah willed that Mus'ab had an encounter with the Prophet in his journey, hence**

becoming attracted to him and embraced Islam. Due to that, Mus‘ab was then ostracized by his own family, his wealth seized, and his stature and nobility stripped away from him. Rasulullah

صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ then groomed Mus'ab  
and sent him to Madeenah  
before the Hijrah to give  
*da'wah* to the Medinans.

Mus'ab then led the effort for  
the Muslims to welcome the  
Hijrah of Rasulullah ﷺ to

**Madeenah, until Rasulullah  
صلی اللہ علیہ وسلم** successfully established  
an Islamic state in Madeenah.  
The role of the believing  
young generation was  
mentioned in al-Qur'an  
through the story of the

young youth of al-Kahf, whom  
protected their ‘*aqeedah*  
from an oppressive king.

Allah *Subhaanahu*

*Wata‘aala* mentions in al-  
Qur'an:



*“It is We who relate to you,  
[O Muhammad], their story  
in truth. Indeed, they were  
youths who believed in their  
Lord, and We increased  
them in guidance. And We  
made*



*firm their hearts when they stood up and said, “Our Lord is the Lord of the heavens and the earth.*

*Never will we invoke besides Him any deity. We would have certainly*



*spoken, then, an  
excessive transgression”  
(al-Kahf 18:13-14)*

**In short, the main roles of  
young Muslims on the face of  
earth are:**

**1. To become servants of  
Allah having utmost *taqwa* on  
this earth.**

**2. Responsible in nurturing  
and developing oneself  
intellectually, spiritually,  
physically, and emotionally.**

**3. To become callers to performing good deeds, which is to incorporate a healthy lifestyle that is according to Islam as a way of life.**

**4. Preventing and hindering  
evil from the widespread of  
wrongdoing and practices  
that contradicts the  
*Sharee'ah* of Islam.**



**5. To become the pioneers,  
movers, and builders of  
Islamic civilization that is  
eminent, respected, and  
revered in the entire world.**



**In the midst of modernity and global advancement in today's borderless world, a plethora of flooding and spillover of immoral cultural values have seeped into nations across the globe.**

**The youth today are not only exposed to the dilemma of drug addiction that is becoming more chronic, but they are also plagued with hedonistic culture that promotes excessive pleasure**

**and entertainment,  
fornication and promiscuity,  
tobacco and drug addiction,  
gambling, intoxication,  
pornography, and many  
other social illnesses that are  
truly worrisome.**

**How can a young generation  
that indulges in this type of  
lifestyle become capable of  
shouldering the *amaanah* as  
leaders to administer,  
manage, as well as  
preserving the sovereignty of**

**the nation and the purity of Islam? Certainly this annoyance is also felt and shared by the future generation today. Therefore, let us altogether unite, cooperate, and responsibly**

**nurture our youth with a  
method and healthy lifestyle  
that is based on the sacred  
teachings of Islam.**

**Allah *Subhaanahu***

***Wata'aala* mentions in al-  
Qur'an:**

*“O you who have believed,  
protect yourselves and your  
families from a Fire whose  
fuel is people and stones,  
over which are [appointed]  
angels, harsh and severe;  
they do not*



*disobey Allah in what He commands them but do what they are commanded”*



*(at-Tahreem 66:6)*

Realizing that the young people, with their large population and strategic position, are to be trained in their ability, skills, and expertise to build the *ummah*, let us altogether

**contribute our resources and  
role within the society as  
pioneers and leaders  
awakening from a long  
slumber. Let us take heed for  
there are many challenges  
and duties that lie ahead,**

**waiting to be resolved. Let us remember that there are more responsibilities and tasks ahead as compared to the time available at hand.**

**Allah *Subhaanahu Wata'aala* mentions in**

al-Qur'an:

*“So direct your face toward  
the correct religion before a  
Day comes from Allah of  
which there is no repelling.*

*That Day, they will be  
divided.*



*Whoever disbelieves - upon  
him is [the consequence  
of] his disbelief. And  
whoever does  
righteousness - they are for  
themselves preparing”*



*(ar-Room 30:43-44)*

To conclude today's *khutbah*,  
let us take as notes and  
lessons that:

1. The Muslim youth must  
always increase their *imaan*,  
*akhlaaq*, and noble  
characteristics for they are

**vital assets and saviors for  
any nation.**

**2. The parents and community  
leaders must strive to enhance  
the image and personal  
characters of the youth, by  
providing**

**complete education and  
guidance as required by**

**Allah *Subhaanahu***

***Wata'aala.***

**3. The Muslim youth must  
abstain from unhealthy  
activities such as the**

**entertainment culture,  
seeking excessive pleasure,  
free mixing between  
opposing genders, deviant  
teachings, and extremist  
movements that can destroy  
the assets of our future**

youth.

4. The youth of today must bring themselves closer to Islamic institutions such as the *masaajid* and *surau*, as well as getting involved in keeping the *masaajid*

**buzzing with activities.**

**5. The society should reach out to the youths by guiding and placing trust upon the youth to carry out activities that are beneficial in upholding the religion and building communities.**

*“[Mention] when the youths  
retreated to the cave and  
said, ‘Our Lord, grant us  
from Yourself mercy and  
prepare for us from our  
affair right guidance”*

*(al-Kahf 18:10)*

**ummah must inculcate noble akhlaaq, having utmost personality and attitude as true Muslims so that the world will know that Rasulullah (صلی اللہ علیہ وسلم) was sent down as a messenger, and Islam that was revealed is mercy**



**for the entire nation and  
universe.**





**O Allah, You are the Lord that  
is All Mighty, we are grateful  
to You for having bestowed  
upon us *rahmah* and *ni'mah*,  
that we are able to continue  
the effort in empowering the  
Muslim *ummah* especially in  
Selangor, as an**
