AQEEDAH





I remind myself and call upon beloved Muslims to strive to increase our imaan and taqwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala by abiding and performing all

of His Commands and avoiding all of His prohibitions. May we always remain upon the correct 'ageedah and not become entangled with the deviants, whom only further deviates.

Today, the khutbah to be delivered is titled "Liberalism Corrupts The 'Ageedah'

Liberalism is an ideology that demands for the

freedom of thought without limitation and rejects the principle of truth in Islam, while opting for the easiest way in religion. It is through liberalism that the Muslim minds have

molded with the mixture of freedom without limit, the freedom to do anything without restriction, censure or discrimination, deemed as the fundamental freedom. If restricted, obstructed or

persecuted, they would be quick to cry to the entire world claiming that their freedom has been violated. Those fighting for liberal ideology would claim that Islam is rigid, retards and

limits progress, and they even attempted to instill fear within the masses by denying the implementation of Islamic laws, claiming that it is unconstitutional for it is unjust, oppressive, and

unsuitable to be implemented where there is a diversity of race and religion, while Islam is a complete religion, divinely revealed by Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala

whom is All-Knowing. Islam is all encompassing, which includes legislations and laws that governs the lives of humans in all aspects for their wellAllah Subhaanahu Wata'aala mentions in al-Qur'an: "So is it other than the religion of Allah they desire, while to Him have submitted [all] those within

the heavens and earth, willingly or by compulsion, and to Him they will be returned?" (Aal-'Imraan 3:83)

Indeed, the onslaught of liberalism has crippled the

minds of the Muslim ummah. The liberals would only resort to logical reasoning in evaluating good and bad, hence rejecting al-Qur'an and as-Sunnah as sources of legislation.

They believe that those committing evil are not guilty for as long as their intention is good.

As an example, the brouhaha not long ago mentioned in

in the media regarding peculiar views by a group of "smarties" that opposed the punishment for khalwat (non-mahram man and woman together in seclusion) in a private

residence for it is the rights and privacy of every individual. Such group claimed that khalwat at a private location constitutes a personal sin between the doer and Allah.

They suggested for the punishment of khalwat to be abolished, as it violates one's freedom. What kind of thinking is this? Would this be the type of ideology that will be inherited by our

children and grandchildren? Is this what these "freedom fighters" really want? The liberty for khalwat and witness innocent infants dumped like animals? Do not be surprised if one finds

an infant in front of the house, where the baby actually turns out to be the child or grandchild of those "freedom fighters." Statistics from the Royal Malaysian Police (PDRM)

revealed that between January and July 2013, a total of 90 cases of baby dumping were recorded. From that amount, 59 infants were found dead. In 2014, a total of 53 cases

recorded for the same duration. From that, 38 infants were found dead. Is this the actual freedom that is being demanded?

I would like to emphasize

that the objectives of drafting laws pertaining to khalwat were to control and prevent greater offense, which is fornication (zinaa). Islam always reminds us to prevent any type of

munkar (evil) for the maslahah (benefit) of the Muslim ummah from falling into the valley of destruction. Therefore, Islam has determined five fundamental objectives (magasia) of the

Sharee'ah that are obligatory to be preserved and protected by all of us, namely:

- 1.Preserving the religion
- 2.Preserving lives
- 3. Preserving the lineage
- 4. Preserving the intellect
- 5.Preserving wealth



Allah Subhaanahu Wata'aala mentions in al-Qur'an: "And do not approach unlawful sexual intercourse. Indeed, it is ever an immorality and...

...is evil as a way" (al-Israa' 17:32)

It was narrated that ibn 'Abbaas radiyAllaahu Canhuma reported that Rasulullah عليه وسلم said:

"O mankind! Verily, I have left behind over you that which if you hold fast to it, you will never go astray: the book of Allah and my sunnah" (al-Haakim)

We should never allow for evil to take place by giving excuses that it is a private matter that cannot be infringed upon. It must be known that freedom in Islam has its limitation

boundaries that must be abided by. The Muslims are prohibited from committing munkar (evil) and ma'siyyah (disobedience) freely as they please. Referring to the ideology

liberalism that is contradictory to the Sharee'ah, the National Fatwa Council's 74th Muzaakarah (discussion) that took place on the 25-27th July 2006 has decided

the liberal thinking ideology is a deviant teaching and heretical from the Sharee'ah of Islam. In addition, the Fatwa Council of Selangor in their June 6th, 2013 meeting has

decided that liberalism and pluralism in religion is a deviant teaching and heretical from Islamic teachings, and this was gazetted on 31st July 2014.

In concluding this khutbah, let us ponder and take lessons that are beneficial for our lives, namely: 1.The Muslim umah must return to the guidance of al-Qur'an

and as-Sunnah by internalizing upon its teachings and applying them in their daily lives, as well as respecting and referring to erudite scholars.

The Muslim ummah must ensure that they do not fall into liberal thinking that could detrimentally weaken their imaan.

The Muslim ummah is obligated to preserve their religion, lives, lineage, intellect, and wealth, as well as giving priority to maslahah 'aammah (benefit for the general public) as compared to personal matters only.

The Muslim ummah must reject ideologies that are deviating and contradicting to the principles of Ahl as-Sunnah wal-Jamaa'ah, which can corrupt one's 'aqeedah.

"Allah, to whom belongs whatever is in the heavens and whatever is on the earth. And woe to the disbelievers from a severe punishment. The ones who prefer the worldly life over the Hereafter and avert [people] from the way of Allah, seeking to make it (seem) deviant. Those are in extreme error" (Ibraaheem 14:2-3) بَارَكَ اللهُ لِيْ وَلَكُمْ فِي الْقُرْآنِ الْعَظِيْمِ وَنَفَعَنِي وَإِيَّاكُمْ بِمَا فِيْهِ مِنَ الأَيَاتِ وَالذَّكْرَ الْحَكِيْمِ وَتَقَبَّلَ مِنِّي وَمِنْكُمْ تِلاَوَتَهُ إِنَّهُ هُوَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيْمُ. أَقُولُ قُولِيْ هَذَا وَأَسْتَغُورُ اللهَ الْعَظِيْمَ لِيْ وَلَكُمْ وَلِسَائِرِ الْمُسْلِمِيْنَ وَالْمُسْلِمَاتِ وَالْمُوْمِنِيْنَ وَالْمُوْمِنَاتِ الْأَحْيَاعِ مِنْهُمْ وَالْأُمْوَاتُ فَاسْتَغْفِرُوْهُ إِنَّهُ هُوَ الْغَفُورُ الرَّحِيْمُ

Once again, I would like to remind all of us that Islam teaches its adherents to remain moderate in all actions and deeds. At the same time, the Muslims are to avoid any form of extremism in which its

consequences will only disrupt the harmony, unity, and security of the Muslim ummah and our nation. Extremism will only give negative impression upon the nobility and holiness of al-Islam. On the contrary, the Muslim

ummah must inculcate noble akhlaaq, having utmost personality and attitude as true Muslims so that the world will know that Rasulullah عليه وسلم was sent down as a messenger, and Islam that was revealed is mercy

for the entire nation and universe.



O Allah, You are the Lord that is All Mighty, we are grateful to You for having bestowed upon us rahmah and ni'mah, that we are able to continue the effort in empowering the Muslim ummah especially in Selangor, as an

advanced state, prosperous, and providing welfare. Hence, we sincerely beseech you, O Allah, strengthen our imaan, accept our deeds, strengthen our unity, ncrease our rizq, enrich us

beneficial knowledge, cultivate our soul with good mannerisms, return us to the path that you are pleased with, protect us from disasters and your severe trials, so that our nation will become more peaceful and filled with blessings.

O Allah, we sincerely beseech you, strengthen our beliefs according to the creed of Ahlus Sunnah wal-Jamaa'ah, and protect us from deeds and 'ageedah that are astray such as the extreme Shee'is, Qadiyani, and other ideologies.

O Allah, open up our hearts in fulfilling the five daily prayers, performing zakaat, and other obligations. Bless those that have fulfilled their zakaat and loving the fugaraa' and masaakeen, and those that have

made wagf and gave up their wealth for Tabung Amanah Pembangunan Islam Selangor (Islamic Development Trust Fund of Selangor) with continuous reward until the Hereafter.

O Allah, increase and widen the rizg of those that made wagf from their wealth with perpetual rewards until the Last Day.





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
