*khutbah* entitled:**

**“ZAKAAT AL-FITR  
PERFECTS THE  
‘IBAADAH OF FASTING”**

The obligation of fulfilling *zakaat al-fitr* has many wisdoms and virtues promised to us by Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala*. Among them:




**1. Zakaat al-fitr as the purification of our soul from the sins that we have committed and conceal our shortfalls throughout our fasting in *Ramadaan*.**

**Narrated ibn 'Abbaas  
*radiyAllaahu 'anhuma*:**

The Messenger of Allah  
(صلی اللہ علیہ وسلم) enjoined zakaat al-fitr as a purification for the fasting person from idle talk and obscenities,

and to feed the poor.  
Whoever pays it before the  
(‘Eid) prayer, it is an  
accepted zakaah, and  
whoever pays it after the  
prayer, it is (ordinary)  
charity”

*(Abu Dawood and ibn Maajah: hasan)*



**2. *Zakaat al-fitr* is obligated upon every Muslim, irrespective of age, gender, and financial background, in allowing the Muslims to share their *rizq* (sustenance) with the**


less fortunate ones. It can be fulfilled in early *Ramadaan*, and must be completed before *Salaat al-'Eidulfitr*. Narrated 'Abdullah ibn 'Umar *radiyAllaahu 'anhuma*:

Allah's Messenger (صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ) prescribed the payment of *zakaat al-fitr* of *Ramadaan* for people, one *saa'* of dried dates or one *saa'* of barley, upon every freeman, or slave,

male and female among  
the Muslims”

*(Muslim)*

3. **Zakaat al-fitr is a way designed by Allah**  
*Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala*  
to



**unite the hearts of the  
Muslims and nurture love  
and togetherness,  
regardless of rank and  
status. The poor and needy,  
whom are *zakaat*  
recipients, will be filled with  
happiness in fulfilling the**

*'ibaadah* of fasting and  
celebrating *'Eidulfitr*.

Furthermore, bringing joy  
amongst mankind is from  
among the deeds that are  
pleasing to Allah

*Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala.*

In the *hadeeth* of ‘Abdullah  
ibn ‘Umar *radiyAllaahu*  
*‘anhuma*: Rasulullah صلى الله عليه وسلم  
said:

“The most beloved  
people to Allah are those  
who are most beneficial

to the people. The most beloved deed to Allah is to make a Muslim happy, or to remove one of his troubles, or to forgive his debt, or to feed his hunger...”

*(al-Asbahaani, ibn Abi ad-Dunya and at-Tabaraani: saheeh)*

4. Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala* has promised *barakah* (blessings), increased *rizq*, happiness, and tremendous rewards for His slaves that fulfills the *zakaat* obligation.

**Especially in fulfilling  
*zakaat* and giving *sadaqah*  
(charity) in this noble month  
of *Ramadaan*. On the  
contrary, the Prophet ﷺ  
had given stern warning to  
those that are miserly  
towards**

others, as mentioned in the narration of Abu Hurayrah *radiyAllaahu 'anh* where Rasulullah ﷺ said:

“...Stinginess is far from Allah, far from Paradise, far from the people

and close to the  
Fire...”



For your kind information,  
the Selangor Fatwa  
Committee has determined  
that the amount

**for zakaat al-fitr for 2016 is  
RM7 per person.**

**Therefore, let us fulfill our  
zakaat al-fitr in fulfilling  
our obligation towards  
Allah *Subhaanahu Wa  
Ta'aala* and towards  
mankind.**

**Based on the reports for  
the collection and  
disbursements of *zakaat*  
*al-fitr* in the state of  
Selangor for 2015, a total of  
RM21.5 million was  
collected from the Muslims  
that had fulfilled**



**their *zakaat al-fitr* in this state. Also in the same year, the Selangor *Zakaat* Board disbursed an amount of RM30.2 million to 44,293 recipients from among the poor and needy.**


**for their preparation in

remind fellow  
congregation, that in this  
blessed month, let us  
hasten to fulfill our**

**obligation of zakaat al-fitr  
in reaping tremendous  
rewards from Allah**

***Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala.***

**Moreover, the poor and  
needy in this state will be  
able to enjoy zakaat  
received from those**



**that had fulfilled it much earlier so that they can celebrate '*Eidulfitr* with happiness.**

**Indeed, the joyfulness of the poor and needy are due to the affection manifested**

through the ‘ibaadah of zakaat that we had all fulfilled. In result, Allah

***Subhaanahu Wa Ta’ala***  
bestows mercy and blessings, as well as mutual love, in the hearts of every

**Muslim that manifests  
*ukhuwwah* (brotherhood)  
and unity of the *ummah*,  
irrespective of rank and  
status amongst humans.  
Therefore, the Muslims  
are called upon to fulfill**

their *zakaat* to the  
collectors appointed by  
the Selangor *Zakaat*  
Board, in upholding the  
*maslahah* (public interest)  
of the Muslims in  
Selangor.

To end the *khutbah*, the  
Muslims must take the  
following measures:

1. The Muslims must fulfill *zakaat al-fitr* with full sincerity, purely for the sake

**of Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala.***

**2. The Muslims must perform the '*ibaadah* of fasting and others with full devotion and perfection.**

**3. The Muslims should fulfill their *zakaat al-fitr* early so as to avoid any inconvenience upon the masses if they are fulfilled in the last moments.**

“Take, [O, Muhammad],  
from their wealth a charity  
by which you purify them  
and cause them increase,  
and invoke [Allah’s  
blessings] upon them.  
Indeed, your invocations

are reassurance for  
them. And Allah is  
Hearing and Knowing”

Malaysian Police for the**


**year 2010 until 2015.**

**In 2015 alone, a total of  
489,606 cases of road  
accidents had occurred with  
more than 6,000 fatal accidents  
causing almost 7,000 deaths  
among**

**motorists across Malaysia. On average, the total accidents have increased by 13,000 cases as compared to 2014, revealing a rate of more than 1,300 accident cases daily with nearly 20 fatalities daily**

**throughout 2015.**

from becoming involved in  
accidents and losses that are  
unexpected, so that we can  
together experience the blessings  
and joy**
