Hence, let us strive to increase our *imaan* and *taqwa* of Allah with *istiqaamah* (steadfastness), by fulfilling all of His Commands and avoiding all of His prohibitions.

Today, I will be delivering
a *khutbah* titled:



**“VACCINE:
PREVENTIVE
MEASURE FOR THE
GREATER BENEFIT”**


Quality living becomes the goal of every human.

Among the things that are noteworthy, in attaining quality living is the aspect of health, which is truly a valuable *ni'mah* (favor) from

Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala*. Without good health, we will not be able to fulfill our duty and obligation as vicegerents on earth.

We must be truly grateful

for the bounty of good health and strive to preserve it, so that we can continue to engage in *'ibaadah*. We are to practice a healthy lifestyle as Rasulullah ﷺ did. We are also to prevent all forms of



illness that can result from our own diet, surrounding, emotions, as well as safeguarding ourselves from falling into destruction.

Recently, the nation was shocked by the epidemic of a contagious disease known as diphtheria, which had claimed the lives of two children, in Malacca and Kedah. Newspapers have

reported that up until the 30th of June 2016, there have been 13 cases of diphtheria across the nation with five deaths involving children. In addition, there were 873 cases of measles outbreak

recorded. Medical examination has discovered that these victims did not receive complete diphtheria immunization and had died due to the complications of the infection. In Selangor,

a total of 23 cases of measles were reported in 2014 and it had increased to 498 cases in 2015, with 408 cases already reported in the first quarter of 2016. Although there was no case

of diphtheria reported in Selangor, the society remains at risk in contracting such virus. The Selangor State Health Department has informed that there are certain quarters within the

**state that had refused
vaccines for their children.**

**Within the context of
health care, among the
vital aspects advocated by
Islam is upholding the very
principle**

of "prevention is better than cure." Islam prohibits all matters that leads to harm upon any individual, by closing and blocking all possibilities that can cause harm and destruction,

as it conforms with the principle of "*prevention of harm is given precedence over attainment of good.*"

Vaccination for immunization is a preventive measure that can prevent

infectious diseases such as measles, tuberculosis, whooping cough, diphtheria, tetanus, and polio. What seems to create doubt within the society is the actual source and *halaal* (lawful)

status of such vaccine! In essence, Islam prohibits using medications originating from *haraam* (unlawful) sources, based on the *hadeeth* of Abu ad-Dardaa' *radiyAllaahu 'anh*

where Rasulullah ﷺ said:

“Allah has sent down both the disease and the cure, and He has appointed a cure for every disease, so treat yourselves medically, but use nothing unlawful”

(Abu Dawood: da'eef)

However, if no cure is found from *halaal* sources, while at the same time a disease must be prevented in preserving the human lives, then it becomes permissible (to resort to non-*halaal* sources)

according to the amount required. This conforms with the *fiqh* maxim that states "*dire necessity makes the prohibited permissible.*"

This maxim of *fiqh* is based upon the verse in al-Qur'an:

“... But whoever is forced [by necessity], neither desiring [it] nor transgressing [its limit], there is no sin upon him. Indeed, Allah is Forgiving and Merciful”

(al-Baqarah 2:173)

According to Dr Wahbah az-Zuhayli *rahimahullaah, darooraat* (dire necessity) refers to a situation that befalls a person and it poses extreme danger or difficulty, where it is feared that

there will be harm inflicted upon one's life, limbs, dignity, intellect, or wealth. At that particular instance, it becomes permissible to engage in what is *haraam* or leaving that which is

waajib (obligatory) or delaying a matter from its prescribed time, all for the sake of avoiding harm from occurring.

The discourse regarding vaccination for

for immunization has been long discussed since 1989 where the National Fatwa Council's *Muzaakarah* (Discussion) had allowed for its practice. This permissibility is based on

the maxims of *fiqh*
mentioned earlier.
The immunization program
through vaccination
implemented by the
Ministry of Health Malaysia
actually coincides with the
Sharee'ah

principle that upholds the preservation of life (*hifdh an-nafs*) for the Muslim *ummah* as an ultimate goal. It is due to this that Islam prohibits all forms of act that can cause the health

and life to fall into destruction.

Therefore, I would like to sincerely advice the Muslims to not make hasty assumptions by spreading information that are

unverified of its authenticity, for it can create *fitnah* and doubtfulness upon the masses. Let us refer to those whom are experts in their respective fields. The parents should not be worried and

Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala*
mentions in al-Qur'an:

“... So ask the people of
the message
[knowledge] if you do
not know”

(*an-Nahl* 16:43)

The measures taken by the Ministry of Health Malaysia in providing immunization vaccine for free is actually in accordance with *fiqh* maxim that states, "*The ruler's decisions must be in favor*

of the people." Those parents that deliberately reject vaccination as a preventive measure have actually placed their children in a high-risk situation that can lead to destruction.

To end this *khutbah*, I would like to firmly reiterate that:

1. The Muslims must have certainty that being sick and healthy is all from Allah
Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala.

2. The Muslims must always supplicate and strive to avoid calamities. However, if catastrophe occurs, one must accept it with patience and contentment.

3. Since vaccination is permissible in Islam, the parents should allow the vaccination of their children as preventive measure against contagious diseases and complications.

4. The Muslims must refer to and inquire from experts within relevant areas in obtaining accurate information.

“Whoever does righteousness - it is for his [own] soul; and whoever does evil [does so] against it. And your Lord is not ever unjust to [His] servants”

(Fussilat 41:46)



THE SECOND KHUTBAH



into**




**committing aggression
