What are the planning that we have made in strengthening the building of a nation that is prosperous and attaining forgiveness

from Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala to be realized in full. Surely there are still numerous roles that we can altogether pursue to continue building an excellent nation and portray clear meaning

of independence for the nation and the people. The 37th verse from Soorah an-Nahl that was recited as the opening verse for today's khutbah had stated that Allah had sent His Messengers

to every nation, beginning from Prophet Adam 'alayhissalaam until His final صلی الله messenger Muhammad Among others, the messengers were sent to free mankind from becoming


slaves of humans or even slaves to the lustful desire that leads to disobedience. Therefore, the planning should be made carefully in providing freedom to every soul so that they can obey

and submit to the bounties of independence bestowed by Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala by taking examples from the struggles of Rasulullah and his Companions.

Planning to fill independence by raising a nation as "Baldatun Tayyibatun Warabbun Ghafoor"is not merely a story within one's imagination or slogan that is pleasing to the ears, but

instead it is a reality that is clear and having solid foundations based upon al-Qur'an, as it was explained by Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala (interpretation of the meaning):


There was for [the tribe of] Sabaa' in their dwelling place a sign: two [fields of] gardens on the right and on the left. [They were told], "Eat from the provisions of vour Lord

to The Almighty. For the knowledge of fard alkifaayah, it necessitates the grooming of citizens that are skilled in mastering the fields of education, science and technology, economics,

A free nation can also incorporate a well-organized educational plan. Having firm 'ageedah, practicing upon In Sharee'ah Islaamiyyah, and having noble akhlaaq are all foundations in the

raising of an *ummah* and nation. It is only with sound religious belief and having skills in various aspects of life that can ensure that the ummah will be spared from the shackles of ignorance,


and not entrapped with deviant teachings, committing shirk with Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala, not lured into extreme activities, and avoiding disputes that can lead to disunity amongst Muslims. 
even though they had diverse background in ethnicity, knowledge, and skills. They were united in loving their nation for the sake of liberating the nation from the grip of the colonialists,

the ample opportunity in this beloved nation by strengthening the silaaturrahm in generating stronger unity. Let us not get swayed by news having elements of fitnah,



"And obey Allah and His Messenger, and do not dispute and [thus] lose courage and [then] your strength would depart; and be patient. Indeed Allah is with the patient." (al-Anfaal 8:46)


