


## RECOGNIZING SOME OF THE

obey all of the commands from Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala and the teachings of Rasulullah عليه وسلم May we become among those blessed by Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala



Today, I invite fellow congregation to contemplate upon a khutbah titled: "Recognizing Some Of The Corrupters"

Al-Qur'an uses the term fasaad (transgression) having a broad range of meaning that generally refers to any type of destruction or corruption on the face of earth, in the form of

activities that are forbidden by Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala. Hence, anyone committing any type of disobedience, evil, or wrongdoing, whether major or minor, has actually

committed mischief. This is clear from the verse recited at the beginning of the khutbah: "And when it is said to them, "Do not cause corruption on the earth," they say, "We are but reformers." Unquestionably, it is they who are the corrupters, but they perceive [it] not" (al-Baqarah 2:11-12) al-Imaam at-Tabari had stated that what is meant by fasaad is kufr (disbelief) and all acts of disobedience. Which means, any activity that leads to the corruption of 'aqeedah can lead to kufr, and this is a very severe catastrophe. In al-Qur'an, there are groups or people that are directly identified as those causing mischief, among them:

1. Oppressive rulers This is as explained by Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala in al-Qur'an: "Indeed, Pharaoh exalted himself in the land and made its people into

factions, oppressing a sector among them, slaughtering their [newborn] sons and keeping their females alive. Indeed, he was of the corrupters" (al-Qasas 28:4) Therefore, anyone who behaves in the same manner as Fir'awn who transgressed against the commands of Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala, breaking the union and unity of the ummah,

suppressing the weak, threatening and forcing the masses to comply to a command though it is wrong according to the Shara', killing innocent lives, committing all sorts of

persecution, injustices, and often-prejudiced, these all are deemed as those committing mischief. Similarly with oppressive rulers known throughout history, they are among the

corrupters on Allah's earth. 2. Those that disbelieved and disobeyed Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala mentions in al-Qur'an:

"And of them are those who believe in it, and of them are those who do not believe in it. And your Lord is most knowing of the corrupters"

(Yoonus 10:40)

Those that disbelieved and even disobeyed Allah are considered to have committed corruption for they refused to abide by the commands of Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala. When they refused or disobeyed to follow the Sharee'ah of Islam, definitely they will perform various deeds that contradict the Sharee'ah. Here is where the mischief takes place.

Furthermore, some of them would openly commit evil such as gambling, establishing casinos, consuming intoxicants, organizing binge-drinking fests, lying, stealing, and

various types of wickedness and disobedience. 3. Hypocrites The hypocrites (munaafigeen) are those that pretend to have imaan, concealing their kufr, and

always plotting to harm Islam. Narrated 'Abdullah ibn 'Amr radiyAllaahu 'anhuma: Rasulullah عليه وسلم said: "Whoever has the following four

(characteristics) will be a pure hypocrite and whoever has one of the following four characteristics will have one characteristic of hypocrisy unless and until

- he gives it up: 1. Whenever he is entrusted, he betrays 2. Whenever he speaks, he tells a lie
- 3. Whenever he makes a covenant, he proves

## treacherous 4. Whenever he quarrels, he behaves in a very imprudent, evil and insulting manner"

(al-Bukhaari)

4. Fitnah maker Fitnah refers to false accusation that is purposely created with the ill intention to disgrace or degrade one's dignity, which could destroy the harmony within,

where in the end it would only sever silaaturrahm within the family and community. This usually occurs through verbal utterances, writings, or actions. Furthermore,

the fitnah maker is also known as the instigator (firebrand). Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala mentions in al-Qur'an: "Who break the covenant

of Allah after contracting it and sever that which Allah has ordered to be joined and cause corruption on earth. It is those who are the losers." (al-Bagarah 2:27) Verily, fitnah causes destruction to the society the moment when people would believe in the slander hurled, for fitnah not only causes enmity and strife but it also could ignite disunity and

chaos. Furthermore, the fitnah maker will not even enter Paradise, as mentioned in the hadeeth of Hudhayfah radiyAllaahu 'anh where Rasulullah عليه وسلم said:

"A Qattaat [talebearer, backbiter or mischief maker] will not enter Paradise" (al-Bukhaari and Muslim) In conclusion, I implore everyone today to act as in the following: 1. The Muslim ummah must remain vigilant and avoid mischief makers that could further corrupt one's

## 'ageedah 2. The Muslim ummah must recognize the characteristics of the corrupters as elaborated in today's khutbah 3. We as Muslims must

cleanse our hearts and soul so as to not become among the corrupters within the society, that we live with security in this world and the Hereafter.

"And of the people is he whose speech pleases you in worldly life, and he calls Allah to witness as to what is in his heart, yet he is the fiercest of opponents. And when he goes away,

he strives throughout the land to cause corruption therein and destroy crops and animals. And Allah does not like corruption."

(al-Baqarah 2:204-205)

advanced state, prosperous, and providing welfare, under the auspices and leadership of our Ruler as the Head of Islamic Affairs in this state.

Hence, we sincerely beseech You, O Allah, strengthen our imaan, accept our deeds, strengthen our unity, increase our rizq, enrich us with beneficial knowledge, cultivate our soul with good mannerisms,
