



## THE **OBLIGATION OF** FULFILING REAL TRANSFORME

Let us altogether strive to increase our taqwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala by fulfilling all of His Commands and avoiding all of His

prohibitions. May Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala bless our lives in this world and the Hereafter.

## In conjunction with this noble day, let us ponder upon a khutbah titled **"THE OBLIGATION OF FULFILLING** ZAKAATAL-FITR."

Fulfilling the zakaat is from among the pillars of Islam, where it is a religious obligation and a social responsibility. The zakaat that is waajib (obligatory) to be fulfilled has two types, namely

zakaat al-fitr and zakaat of wealth. Both have profound effects in building akhlaaq upon mankind. Despite the small amount that is to be fulfilled for zakaat al-fitr, it truly carries a deep

meaning behind such righteous deed.

**Referring to zakaat al-fitr**, it is an obligation that is to be fulfilled by every **Muslim individual by** giving away staple food

at a measurement of a ratl Baghdadi (sa'), which is equivalent to 2.7 kilogram or RM7, as determined by the **Selangor Fatwa Committee**.

**Based on the decision by** the Selangor Fatwa **Committee, the Muslims** are highly recommended to fulfill their zakaat al-fitr according to the price of rice that is typically consumed by individuals

and families. For example, if one is accustomed to the Imported White Rice or Brown Rice for daily consumption, then it is recommended to fulfill zakaat al-fitr according to the price value of that

rice, which is RM14 per person. Similarly if one **consumes Basmathi Rice** for himself or his family, then it is recommended to fulfill zakaat al-fitr according to the price value of that rice, which

#### is RM21 per person.

The recommendation in fulfilling zakaat al-fitr according to the price of rice consumed is based on the narration of صلى الله on the عليه وسلم Rasulullah

#### authority of Abu Sa'eed al-Khudri *radiyAllaahu 'anh*:

#### "In the lifetime of Allah's Messenger (عليه وسلم), we used to give one Sa'of food (edible things) as

sadagat al-fitr (to the poor). Our food used to be either of barley, raisins (dried grapes), cottage cheese or dates."

(al-Bukhaari)

Zakaat also has a higher objective with respect to human lives, whether as individuals or as a society, because with the fulfillment of zakaat, the hearts,

souls, and society will become pure and cleansed. Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala mentions in verse 103 of soorah at-Tawbah:

*"Take, [O,* Muhammad], from their wealth a charity by which you purify them and cause them increase..."

Furthermore, let us comprehend the hadeeth of ibn 'Abbaas radiyAllaahu 'anhuma:

*"The Messenger of Messenger of Allah (عليه وسلم) والله angine ( عليه وسلم) والله angine ang* 

zakaat al-fitr on the one who fasts to purify him from any indecent act or speech and for the purpose of providing food for the needy. It is accepted as zakaah for

the person who pays it before the 'Eid prayer and it is sadaqah (voluntary charity) for the person who pays it after the 'Eid prayer." (Abu Dawood) This hadeeth explains to us that if zakaat al-fitr is fulfilled after salaat al-'Eid, then it is not considered as zakaat alfitr but as regular charity (sadaqah) instead.

Moreover, al-Imaam ash-Shaafi'i rahimahullaah mentioned: "Prioritize in fulfilling zakaat al-fitr from the beginning of the month of Ramadaan."

Alhamdulillaah, the awareness amongst the **Muslims in fulfilling** zakaat al-fitr nowadays is something to be proud of. For my respected audience's information, based on the zakaat al-fitr

distribution report in Selangor for 2018, a total of RM35.08 million has been distributed to 50,023 recipients from among the poor and needy in this state, for their preparation in

celebrating Ramadaan and 'Eidulfitr.

Verily, those who have fulfilled their zakaat obligation have clearly manifested their gratefulness upon the

bounties and provisions bestowed by Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala* upon them.

Through the fulfillment of *zakaat*, Islam is able to create the best social system where mutual aiding between the wealthy and the poor can be realized.

# From among the wisdom of *zakaat al-fitr*.

1. Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala promises barakah (blessings), increase in rizq (provision), and a plethora of rewards for those that fulfill zakaat al-fitr.

2. Fulfilling zakaat can eradicate arrogance, stinginess, and selfishness. Whilst miserliness is greatly abhorred by the Prophet صلى الله as mentioned in the hadeeth of Abu Hurayrah *radiyAllaahu 'anh*, where صلى الله Baid:

*"...Stinginess is far from Allah, far from Paradise, far from the people and close to the Fire..."* 

(at-Tirmidhi)

3. Zakaat al-fitr that is fulfilled can bring joy especially happiness in celebrating 'Eid and eliminate distress upon the fugaraa' (poor) and masaakeen (needy).

This is based on another hadeeth of Abu Hurayrah radiyAllaahu 'anh صلى الله where Rasulullah عليه وسلم said:

### "Whoever is easy with one who is in difficulty, Allah will be easy with him in this world and in the Hereafter." (ibn Maajah)

As a reminder for all of us, in addition to zakaat al-fitr, let us not forget to fulfill our zakaat of wealth when the conditions are met. Let us take this very opportunity that Allah has blessed us with in this

noble month to reap all of the rewards that are greatly multiplied by fulfilling the obligation of zakaat upon our income, savings, gold, commerce, agricultural

produce, and others. It is truly hoped that with those righteous deeds, Allah will increase rizq and barakah in our lives.

In ending the khutbah on a day that is full of barakah, let us take beneficial lessons as in the following:

1. It is waajib upon the Muslim ummah to have certainty that all of the **commands from Allah** are waajib to be fulfilled, including zakaat.

2. The Muslim ummah is advised to fulfill zakaat al-fitr during early Ramadaan so that it can be benefited by its recipients while fasting and on 'Eidulfitr.

3. The Muslim ummah must fulfill the zakaat of wealth when its conditions have been fulfilled.

4. The Muslim ummah should increase in giving charity and zakaat in the noble month of Ramadaan, for there are tremendous virtues and rewards that awaits in the Hereafter.

"Certainly will the believers have succeeded: They who are during their prayer humbly submissive. And they who turn away from ill speech. And they who are observant of zakaah." (al-Mu'minoon 23:1-4)

**Once again, I would like to** remind all of us to always have the taqwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala and realize that Islam teaches us to remain moderate in every actions and



deeds. As Muslims, we are to manifest noble akhlaaq, having utmost personality and attitude for Rasulullah صلى الله was sent to عليه وسلم perfect akhlaaq and as mercy for the entire mankind and the worlds. Therefore, let us



always increase our salawaat and salaam upon our Prophet Muhammad صلى الله Allah عليه وسلم Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala **mentions:** 



"Indeed, Allah confers blessing upon the Prophet, and His angels [ask Him to do so]. O you who have believed, ask [Allah to confer] blessing upon him and ask [Allah to grant him] peace." (al-Ahzaab 33:56)



**O Allah, You are the Lord that is** All Mighty, we are grateful to You for having bestowed upon us rahmah and ni'mah, that we are able to continue the effort in empowering the Muslim ummah, as an advanced state,



## prosperous and providing welfare, under the auspices and leadership of our Ruler as the Head of Islamic affairs in this state.



Hence, we sincerely beseech You, O Allah, strengthen our imaan and creed according to that of Ahl as-Sunnah wal-Jamaa'ah, accept our righteous deeds, cultivate our soul with good mannerisms, unite our



hearts, bestow upon us rizg with blessings, enrich us with beneficial knowledge, protect us from disasters and save us from teachings that are outside the fold of Islam such as Qadiyaani, deviant teachings such as
