







Those the from category of asnaf Ar-Rigaab are from among those that are qualified to receive zakaah. Allah Subhaanahu Ta'aala has determined

the eight (8) categories of people that are eligible as zakaat recipients (asnaf), as He mentions in verse 60 of soorah at-Tawbah:

"Zakaah expenditures are only for the poor and for the needy and for those employed to collect [zakaah] and for bringing hearts together [for Islam] and for freeing captives [or slaves] and

for those in debt and for the cause of Allah and for the [stranded] traveler - an obligation [imposed] by Allah. And Allah is Knowing and Wise."

After examining closely differences the of opinion among the fuqahaa' (Muslim jurists) in interpreting those that are eligible to receive zakaat under

the category of ar-Rigaab captives (freeing or slaves), as well as evaluating the maslahah (general interest) of the Muslim ummah today, the Fatwa Selangor Committee has allowed

for the usage of collected zakaat funds to aid asnaf ar-Riqaab that are plagued by social and 'aqeedah (creed) problems. The Fatwa on the Recipients of Asnaf ar-Riqaab in Selangor

and Matters Pertaining To Them has been gazetted on the 7th of June 2012 to further elaborate on individuals that are eligible to receive zakaat funds within the category of ar-Riqaab.

Among those that fall under the category of enduring social ills are those that are shackled by drug abuse, Sharee'ah criminal acts, practices that clearly violate Islamic teachings such

as abandoning salaah and fasting, perverted lifestyle, juvenile cases, and others. While, those that are within the category of having 'aqeedah issues are

those engulfed with shirk and khurafaat (superstition), as well as individuals that have deviated from pure teachings of Islam.

This clearly shows that Islam does not marginalize these groups, even though they are typically looked down upon by the society. Moreover, various aid has been channeled to

asnaf ar-Rigaab for the purpose of educating and guiding them unto becoming believers pleasing to that are Allah.

To get to know more about asnaf ar-Rigaab, the Selangor Islamic Religious Council (MAIS) has organized asnaf ar-Rigaab liberation month, in providing exposure to the general public,

specifically the youth, regarding the reality and danger of social ills upon individuals and its impact upon the religion, people, and nation.

When speaking about asnaf ar-Riqaab, surely we will be discussing upon social diseases that are becoming rampant such as zinaa (adultery), drug abuse, LGBT, rape, juvenile cases and

offenses in Islam, where they all must be given serious attention by all walks of society. Therefore, several measures must be taken in dealing with social ills within the society.

## Among them:

1. Children must be given full attention on constant basis by the parents, such as ensuring that they are equipped with adequate preparation

problems in facing and emotional stress, wellacceptance any outcome, having a positive attitude, and knowing their children's friends, so as to not plunge into the valley of

disobedience and traits of madhmoomah (blameworthy).

2. Great emphasis on religious education must be heavily stressed by all walks of society.

Attending religious lessons and the culture of inviting the masses to in jamaa'ah pray (congregation) must be encouraged so as to instill love upon the religion. Having love for

the religion will instill awe and fear from committing disobedience, asserted by Rasulullah in the hadeeth of 'Abdullah bin Mas'ood radiyAllaahu 'anh:

"A believer sees his sins as if he were sitting under a mountain which, he is afraid, may fall on him; whereas the

wicked person considers his sins as flies passing over his nose and he just drives them away like this."

(al-Bukhaari)

3. Counselling sessions and student personality development program in schools and higher tertiary institutions must be conducted consistently and updated according to the passage

of time, so as to that ensure preventive measures for social ills can be executed with greater effectiveness.

4. Law enforcement must go hand-in-hand with awareness programs. Laws that transparent will aid in preventing ma'siyyah (disobedience) and munkar (evil).

The preventive aspect is to prevent humans from committing evil. Preventive efforts will bear its fruit when there is fear within the members of society upon the punishments imposed.

5. Issues pertaining to 'ibaadah (worship) must be taken seriously, no matter who one may be, and they must be given utmost priority beginning with the family institution. This is because those

that preserve their 'ibaadah will safeguard their 'aqeedah. Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala mentions in verse 45 of soorah al-'Ankaboot:

"Recite, Muhammad], what has been revealed to you of the Book and establish prayer. Indeed, prayer prohibits immorality

and wrongdoing, and the remembrance of Allah is greater. And Allah knows that which you do."

conclusions The that can be derived from this Friday sermon are:

1. Aiding asnaf ar-Rigaab is a command from Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala and it is proof for the concern that Islam has mankind, upon irrespective of individual backgrounds.

2. Islam always provides the opportunity for every human being to become remorseful upon their mistakes and become believers that are to pleasing Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala.

3. The Muslim ummah must have positive attitude and not continue to judge those that have gone overboard committing misdeeds.

4. The Muslim ummah must realize that free mixing and those beyond the limits of Islam are among the causes for social diseases within the young generation today.

"O you who have believed, repent to Allah with sincere repentance. Perhaps your Lord will remove from you your misdeeds and admit you into gardens beneath which rivers flow [on] the

Day when Allah will not disgrace the Prophet and those who believed with him. Their light will proceed before them and on their right; they will say,

"Our Lord, perfect for us our light and forgive us. Indeed, You are over all things competent.""

(at-Tahreem 66:8)

## THE SECOND KHUTBAH

our state and nation from destruction due to bribery. Render the duty to lead our country upon Your slaves whom are trustworthy and honest, as well as firm and courageous in upholding

the truth and executing justice according to the Sharee'ah. O Allah, make the masaajid and suraus in the state of Selangor as Your peaceful homes,
