His prohibitions. Let us give our undivided attention to the sermon that is to be delivered. Let us not speak and get carried away with our mobile phones. May this khutbah benefit all of us.

Today I will be expounding on a khutbah titled

Islam is built upon five essential matters and performing salaah (prayer) is one of them. The obligation of fulfilling salaah is shouldered upon every Muslim that is mukallaf (accountable),

whether male or female, that is to be fulfilled during the prescribed times. There are many verses of al-Qur'an that commands the Muslim ummah to perform salaah.

Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala mentions in verse 103 of Soorah an-Nisaa':

إِنَّ ٱلصَّلُوٰةَ كَانَتُ عَلَى ٱلْمُؤْمِنِينَ وَاللَّهُ وَمِنِينَ كَانَتُ عَلَى ٱلْمُؤْمِنِينَ وَقُوتًا كَتَابًا مُوقُونًا مُؤْفُونًا

"Indeed, prayer has been decreed upon the believers a decree of specified times."

Salaah can cleanse the souls of the Muslim ummah from minor sins committed in the past. With that, the prayer that is performed with istiqaamah (steadfastness)

in all circumstances will take us closer to Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala and always remaining under His Rahmah (mercy). In the hadeeth of Abu Hurayrah radiyAllaahu 'anh, Rasululah said:

"Five prayers and from one Friday prayer to (the next) Friday prayer is an expiation (of the sins committed in between their intervals) if major sins are not committed."

(Muslim)

Safeguarding the salaah and performing them will make us pure and cleansed from dispraised traits (mazhmoomah). The prayers performed are not merely to fulfill its obligation, but it can

make us among those that would save ourselves and others continuously doing good deeds and having virtuous akhlaaq (character). The salaah performed will prevent us

from committing munkar (evil) and wicked acts. Our hearts will become tranquil when we observe and perform salaah. Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala mentions in verses 19 to 23 of Soorah al-Ma'aarij:

"Indeed, mankind was created anxious: When evil touches him, impatient. And when good touches him, withholding [of it]. Except the observers of prayer. Those who are constant in their prayer."

Let us not become like those that take it lightly when it comes to observing the prayer. Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala has given stern warning in al-Qur'an that there will be those that

are heedless when it comes to salaah, hence they will live according to their desire, lust (shahwah), and committing disobedience.

They will be the ones severely tormented.

Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala mentions in verse 59 of Soorah Maryam:

"But there came after them successors who neglected prayer and pursued desires; so they are going to meet evil."

In the hadeeth of ibn 'Abbaas radiyAllaahu 'anhuma, Rasulullah Said:

"Be mindful of Allah and He will protect you. Be mindful of Allah and you will find Him before you."

(at-Tirmidhi)

To be mindful of Allah is performing the obligatory prayers and fulfilling all of the commandments and leaving out all of His prohibitions. If we are mindful of Allah, Allah will protect us by

granting the nobility of His religion and preserve the honor of our lives in this world and the Hereafter.

There are still many within the Muslim ummah that abandon the salaah, while Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala has given severe threat to His servants that are negligent in the

'ibaadah (worship) of whether salaah, intentionally or whatever the case may be. Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala mentions in verses 42 and 43 of Soorah al-Muddaththir:

"[And asking the criminals], "What put you into Saqar?" They will say, "We were not of those who prayed.""

In the *hadeeth* of ibn 'Abbaas *radiyAllaahu* 'anhuma, Rasulullah

Said:

مَنْ تَرَكَ الصَّلاةَ لَقِيَ اللَّهُ وَهُوَ عَلَيْهِ عَلَيْهِ مَنْ تَرَكَ الصَّلاةَ لَقِيَ اللَّهُ وَهُوَ عَلَيْهِ غَضْبَانُ عَضْبَانُ

"Whoever abandons the prayer, then he will meet Allah in His wrath."

(al-Bazzaar and at-Tabaraani)

It was stated in al-Figh al-Islaamiy wa Adillatuhu by the late Shaykh Dr. Wahbah az-Zuhailiy rahimahullaah that the one that abandons salaah in denying its obligation (fard) is

deemed as murtad (apostated). While those that do not pray due to laziness (تکاسُل) and feeling unconcerned (تَهَاوُن), then the ruling is faasiq (transgressor) and committing disobedience.

In Kitaab as-Salaah, ibn al-Qayyim al-Jawziyyah rahimahullaah explained that abandoning the five obligatory prayers intentionally will be deemed as committing the greatest sin,

even greater than the killing, sins plundering the wealth of others, committing adultery, stealing, and consuming intoxicants.

Rasulullah also made comparison between those having imaan (belief) and having kufr (disbelief), as mentioned in the hadeeth of Jaabir bin 'Abdullah radiyAllaahu 'anhuma, where he said:

"Between man and shirk and disbelief is the abandonment of salaah."

(Muslim)

One can be ruled as kaafir (disbeliever) if he rejects the obligation of salaah. Those that forgot or intentionally heedless in the 'ibaadah of salaah according prescribed times, it is

waajib (obligatory) upon them to make up for those prayers immediately during the time of other prayers. The hukm (ruling) is that they are sinful and it is waajib for them to hasten

in performing *tawbah* (repentance) if they had purposely neglected them.

Therefore, let us instill solemn determination

within ourselves and call upon our family members to continue to remain istiqaamah in performing the five obligatory Strive to prayers. them perform in jamaa'ah (congregation)

at the masjid or surau. Perfect our salaah by performing the sunnah (supererogatory) prayers such as the qabliyyah and ba'diyyah.

To end the sermon, us derive let lessons upon the following matters:

1. The Muslim ummah must have certainty that the decree to perform the five daily prayers had came from Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala.

2. The Muslim ummah must remain cognizant that grave punishment will befall those that are negligent in their 'ibaadah of salaah.

3. The Muslim ummah must have certainty with the promise and guarantee from Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala those that upon safeguard their prayers.

"And enjoin prayer upon your family [and people] and be steadfast therein. We ask you not for provision; We provide for you, and the [best] outcome is for [those of] righteousness." (Soorah Ta-Ha 20:132)

THE SECOND KHUTBAH

Once more, I would like to remind all of us to always have the tagwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala by protecting ourselves and our families from committing acts of disobedience and abominable

deeds. At the same time, we continue to supplicate so that we will always be blessed and protected from all forms of threat and the spread of Covid-19 endemic. The Muslims are advised to practice self-care

mindful of and one's be hygiene personal and surroundings by adhering to **SOP** has been that the stipulated avoiding in contagion.

O Allah, O our Lord! Save our Muslim brethren whom are oppressed in the land of Palestine, and wherever they may be.

Remove all the tyranny that exist on this earth. Bestow justice upon those that have been mistreated and oppressed.

O Allah! Make us among Your slaves that fulfills the amaanah. Strengthen our imaan so that we avoid treachery, protect us from becoming among those that neglect their responsibilities,

and protect our state and nation from destruction due to bribery. Render the duty to lead our country upon Your slaves whom are trustworthy and honest,

as well as firm and courageous in upholding the truth and executing justice according to the Sharee'ah. O Allah, make the masaajid and suraus in

the state of Selangor as Your peaceful homes, uniting everyone, and serve as the heart of the ummah's strength.
