THE NOBILITY OF THE NIGHT OF AL-QADR

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Ramadaan is a month that is full of barakah (blessings). In it, there is a night that is better than a thousand months of worship, which is within the last ten nights of Ramadaan. Those days

are truly special and precious for every Muslim. Hence, in this last third of Ramadaan, the Muslims must seize the irresistible offer promised by Allah with

Laylat (Night) al-Qadr. On the authority of Jaabir bin Samurah radiyAllaahu 'anh. صلى الله Basulullah عليه وسلم said:

"Seek it [i.e. Laylat al-Qadr] in the odd numbered nights of the last ten nights."

(Ahmad)

ten nights of In the last Ramadaan, there are blessings that are uncountable. One of the most significant nights that we must truly benefit from is Laylat al-Qadr (Night of **Power or Decree), a night**

that is greater than a thousand month. In these very special moments, let us reflect upon the virtues available within that night. The blessings of the last ten nights of **Ramadaan appears with**

increased intensity in (worship), *'ibaadah* khushoo' (awe) in salaah, and performing righteous deeds with full sincerity. All of these will be rewarded and even multiplied manifold by

Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala. This is because Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala has made the night of al-Qadr as a very special night within Ramadaan and all of the deeds performed on that

night will be multiplied in its rewards. This is based on what Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala mentions in verses 1-3 of Soorah al-Qadr:

"Indeed, We sent the Qur'an down during the Night of Decree. And what can make you know what is the Night of **Decree?** The Night of Decree is better than a thousand months."

Therefore, in our very effort to seize the blessings within the last ten nights of Ramadaan, there are several matters that we must pay attention to. First, to comprehend the value of

privilege. We must understand how special are the last few nights of Ramadaan, among them is the presence of Laylat al-Qadr, a night that is full of barakah and forgiveness from

Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala*, and that it is better than a thousand months of worship.

Second, the recommended deeds. Among the practices that are

recommended for the last ten nights is the night (tahajjud), prayer recitation of al-Qur'an, in *dhikr* engaging (remembrance of Allah), du'aa making (supplication),

giving sadaqah (charity), and indulging in other 'ibaadah. Aside from that, highly are we encouraged to perform i'tikaf (spiritual retreat) in the masjid. I'tikaf that is recommended and

attains the reward of i'tikaf is actually by performing the i'tikaf in the masjid, not at the surau, musalla, or at home.

is to perform Third the night prayer. We are highly encouraged to increase in our night prayer. Abu Hurayrah **radiy**Allaahu 'anh narrated that Rasulullah Said:

"Whoever prays during the night in Ramadaan out of sincere faith and seeking its reward from Allah, will have all of his previous sins forgiven." (al-Bukhaari)

Increasing in our supplication and performing the tahajjud in the night are deeds that are highly encouraged in the last ten nights of Ramadaan. Abu Hurayrah radiyAllaahu 'anh

narrated that Rasulullah said:



"Every night when it is the last third of the night, our Lord, the Superior, the Blessed,

descends to the nearest heaven and says: Is there anyone to invoke Me that I may respond to his invocation? Is there anyone to ask Me so

that I may grant him his request? Is there anyone asking My forgiveness so that I may forgive him?" (al-Bukhaari)

Next is to revive the final nights of Ramadaan. We are to revive last few nights of Ramadaan by decorating it with 'ibaadah and devotion to Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala, as well as

leaving out deeds that are in vain and wastes time. We are encouraged to make time for the recitation of al-Qur'an with khushoo' and tadabbur (reflection). Ponder upon the

meaning of the verses that we recite and make effort to derive lessons and teachings from them. We can also benefit from the final nights of by giving Ramadaan charity and sharing

rizq (provision) with others that are in need. This is the suitable time to perform more good deeds and strengthen the unity amongst mankind.

То increase in supplication and beg for forgiveness. Let us increase in our du'aa and seeking forgiveness from Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala so that we will be bestowed with blessings,

expiation of our previous sins, granted ease in performing 'ibaadah and in the journey of the Hereafter. Increasing in supplication in the final nights of Ramadaan is a practice that is highly

recommended. When making prayer, open up our hearts and express the du'aa with full ikhlaas (sincerity) and determination unto Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala. **Plead for forgiveness**

from Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala for all of the wrongdoings and sins that we have committed. Be resolute in seeking forgiveness, and promise to improve ourselves in the future.

Beseech Allah Wa Subhaanahu Ta'aala so that we are goodness, granted mercy, and blessings in this life, for us and the entire mankind.

I would like to remind everyone to not commit things that are unbeneficial and in vain, in these final moments of Ramadaan. Let us not get tied up with things that can incur harm such as

purchasing and burning homemade fireworks, bamboo cannon, and its like. Let us advice our household members and children to avoid matters that are dangerous, wasteful, and causing

disturbance upon those performing *'ibaadah*.

To end the *khutbah* today, let us derive several lessons as guidance for all of us, namely:

1. We must remain diligent in increasing our 'ibaadah such as salaah, dhikr, recitation of al-Qur'an, and making du'aa so that we will attain tremendous rewards from Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala.

2. Whoever wants to perform 'ibaadah with simple deeds but having the equivalent reward of over 83 years of 'ibaadah, then let him or her indulge in good deeds in the night of al-Qadr.

3. The Muslim ummah must seize the golden opportunity in the last ten nights of Ramadaan, in becoming closer to Allah, reflecting upon all of His favors, making tawbah (repentance) and

having the determination to become a better person in the time to come.



"And whoever does righteous deeds, whether male or female, while being a believer - those will enter Paradise and will not be wronged, [even as much as] the speck on a date seed." (Soorah an-Nisaa' 4:124)
