## On this glorious day, I will discuss upon the topic of...



(piety) Taqwa is preserving good relationship with Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala, safeguarding oneself from committing acts that are not pleasing to Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala.

It is to preserve and obey all of His Commands and staying away from all of His prohibitions.

In the *hadeeth* of Abu Dharr *radiyAllaahu 'anh*, Rasulullah عليه وسلم said:

"Allah, the Almighty, says: 'Whosoever does a good deed, will have (reward) ten times like it and I add more; and whosoever does an evil, will have the punishment like it or I will forgive (him); and

whosoever approaches Me by one span, I will approach him by one cubit; and whosoever approaches Me by one cubit, I approach him by one fathom, and whosoever comes to Me

walking, I go to him running; and whosoever meets Me with an earthload of sins without associating anything with Me, I meet him with forgiveness like that."

(Muslim and Ahmad)

Verily, taqwa is the key to success for every for Allah believer, Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala will always be with His servants whom constantly submit to His Will and have taqwa upon

Him at all times, whether at ease or afflicted with problems or calamities. Moreover, it becomes provision in attaining blissfulness and salvation in this world and the Hereafter.

Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala mentions in verse 197 of soorah al-Baqarah: "And take provisions,

but indeed, the best provision is fear of Allah. And fear Me, O you of understanding."

The slave having taqwa has full certainty that his obedience upon his Creator will not be left in vain by Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala. The taqwa of the servant who proclaims having imaan (faith) in

Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala is not something optional, instead the taqwa of Allah is a matter that must be instilled within all of our actions for as long as we are still breathing. Taqwa is not

something that is only in certain present situations, but it is born out of unwavering belief. It is with utmost patience, diligence, jihaad, and great sacrifice that sets aside worldly pleasures.

Narrated Abu Hurayrah radiyAllaahu 'anh, Rasulullah صلى الله said: "Leave me as I leave

you, for the people who were before you were ruined because of their questions and their

differences over their prophets. So, if I forbid you to do something, then keep away from it. And if I order you to do something, then do of it as much as you can."

(al-Bukhaari)

In conjunction with Labor Day on the 1st of May, let us altogether instill taqwa within by utilizing our work or employment as a daily activity that brings us closer to Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala.

The work performed must originate from halaal (lawful) sources and spent upon what is halaal, so as to attain barakah (blessings) in this world and goodness in the Hereafter.

On the authority of Abu Hurayrah *radiyAllaahu 'anh*, Rasulullah عليه وسلم said:

"Whoever seeks halaal sustenance to protect himself from begging, and with the aim of providing for his family,

as well as being able to help his neighbors, he will surely come on the Day of Resurrection with his face shining like the moon on a full moonnight."

(al-Bayhaqi)

As a worker, whether self-employed or working for a certain employer, let us work with great enthusiasm, amaanah (trustworthy), and avoid munkar (evil) acts. Let us utilize our work as

'ibaadah (worship) and a means in seeking the of Allah pleasure Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala purely hoping for barakah from Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala. Nafaqah (financial support) and

living necessities are waajib (obligatory) to be fulfilled. So let us have the intention to provide nafaqah and seek employment for the sake of Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala Alone.

However, the proper (intention) niyyah according to the shara' should coincide with the deeds undertaken based on the intention. Hence, for every work undertaken purely for

Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala be must with performed earnestness full and diligence.

In performing work diligently and earnestly,

level of utilizing high thinking and the four limbs, shara' obligations must be preserved, specifically the five daily prayers. This indicates that the salawaat (prayers) teaches us to

manage our time wisely, striving unto becoming a mu'min (believer) that upholds the amaanah, and fulfills his promises to Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala. Aside from that, Muslims that are

obedient and firmly preserves their five daily prayers are likened to upholding their beloved religion.

It was narrated that Abu 'Abdirrahmaan 'Abdullah

bin Mas'ood radiyAllaahu 'anh said: 'I asked the Messenger of Allah ( ) which action is most beloved to Allah?' He صلى الله replied, عليه وسلم 'Establishing prayer on time.'

ensure When working, is with that it earnestness and do not leave out other obligations. Workers having taqwa will surely avoid any form of disobedience and sinful

who would still commit disobedience and misbehave from among the employees, whether consciously or not.

Among the disobedience and mischiefs that are

found to persist are power abuse and bribery, which by are one's manipulating position to obtain personal gain. Bribery and abuse of power are also found to be

"protected" when they are committed en masse and in a structured manner within an organization.

These mischiefs occur when an employee at a particular rank believes

that his or her stature is privileged and has the authorization that allows the person to abandon the responsibility and amaanah bestowed. The evil acts of bribery and power abuse truly

prevents, restrains, and hinders the of implementation development policies, while at the same time it obstructs the citizens receiving, from experiencing, and

enjoying the benefits from state and national development progress.

In that regard, let us ensure that all within the working corp do not commit matters that are

prohibited, oppressive, to the detrimental economy, and hinders the formation and developed harmonious nation. must be remembered that bribery becomes the

norm because it all began as a trial, where in the end one becomes brazen in committing them that it becomes the norm, and even a genuine and proper necessity.

Bribery Remember! occurs due to three matters. First: due to urgent need. Second: due to greed and uncontrolled love for worldly gain. Third: due to weak employment

system or failure in its enforcement. Therefore, the pious worker must live according to his wages. Live this life within one's means, not based on one's limitless desires. Always perform

our task with amaanah, integrity, and ikhlaas (sincerity), becoming a good employee wherever we may be. Avoid from becoming workers that are fussy with the given tasks and difficult in

cooperating with fellow co-workers, for it is not a manifestation of taqwa. Moreover, it is a manifestation of one's selfishness.

History has taught us that it is selfishness that became the cause for the collapse of the Islamic State, and enmity among Muslims. Let us take lessons

from the stories of the past with full regret and penitence, and let us not become those that would cause history to repeat itself.

To end this khutbah, let us altogether ponder and derive lessons as follows:

1. The Muslim ummah must always strive to increase its taqwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala while pursuing worldly affairs, and attain nearness to Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala.

2. The Muslims remain farsighted accomplishing their work, while at the same time always remembering death and prepared with provisions for the Hereafter.

3. The Muslims must safeguard the amaanah and have integrity at work, as well as avoiding evil and disobedience that can cause damage and

destruction upon oneself, one's family, and the society.

"O you who have believed, do not betray Allah and the Messenger or betray your trusts while you know [the consequence]."
