to altogether strive in increasing our taqwa of Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala by performing all of His Commands and staying away from all of

His prohibitions. Let us give full attention to the sermon that is to be delivered. Do not speak and do not get carried away with the cellular phone. May this khutbah benefit us all.

On this blessed day and in conjunction with the Unity Week Program for the state of Selangor, I will expound on khutbah titled:

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#bahagian pengurusan masjid

The unity of the ummah, specifically within the Muslim ummah, is a union that is Rabbaani (God-centric) in nature, for it is based upon Divine guidance. The basis, concept, and

guidance for the unity of the Muslim ummah has been mentioned in various verses of al-Qur'an and ahaadeeth. Among them is the verse that was recited during the early part of the khutbah:

"Indeed this, your religion, is one religion, and I am your Lord, so worship Me."

Verse 92 from Soorah al-Anbiyaa' depicts the Muslim ummah as an ummah that subscribes to one religion. Its basic fundamentals are belief, devotion, and full submission to the will of

Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala, The One And Only God. This is the religion of Islam, which is a religion that heavily emphasizes on unity based on al-Qur'an,

as-Sunnah, and Qudwah Hasanah (best exemplary).

Unity within the Muslim ummah is not merely an external necessity, but it is a bond of brotherhood or

ukhuwwah Islaamiyyah fostered through imaan (faith) and Islam. This bond of brotherhood is woven across borders and boundaries of nations, as in the

proverb "cubit peha kanan, peha kiri akan terasa" (when the right thigh is pinched, the left thigh feels the pain).

In the hadeeth of an-Nu'maan bin Basheer radiyAllaahu 'anh, Rasulullah said:

"You see the believers as regards their being merciful among themselves and showing love among themselves and being kind, resembling one body,

so that, if any part of the body is not well then the whole body shares sleeplessness and fever with it."

(al-Bukhaari)

Solid relationship between members of society that truly love each other and mutually aiding one another can be seen among the Companions. Al-Baghaawi explained in

the meaning of verse 29 of soorah al-Fath that those who were with were willing Were Rasulullah affectionate and compassionate towards each other, stating: "They sympathize and love one

another like a child towards his father." The or 'among word them' in that verse explains being that merciful within the Muslim ummah is an identity for that society.

Malaysia is a country that is very unique, even though it is populated by people of various creed, color, and ethnicity. Islam remains as the official religion of the Federation, however

Malaysians that comprise of various races and beliefs are free to practice their own faith. This very freedom forms the national unity that is firm among diverse ethnicities and the

formation of Malaysian national identity.

Islam as a way of life that (allshumool is encompassing) provides the complete guidance regarding the rulings,

laws, and etiquette pertaining to the life of the Muslim ummah alongside non-Muslim communities. The principles outlined includes tolerance, justice, welfare, and

compassion for fellow Muslim and non-Muslim citizens. The main principle is to serve everyone equally except for some aspects. Moreover, the Prophet firmly asserted that, as in

the narration of Safwaan bin Sulaym *radiyAllaahu 'anh*, where he said:

"Beware, if anyone wrongs a contracting man, or diminishes his right, or forces him to

work beyond his capacity, or takes from him anything without his consent, I shall plead for him on the Day of Judgment."

(Abu Dawood)

Islam, in general, drives mankind throughout their lives. Through religious teachings, mankind is well-informed regarding truth and falsehood. With religion, mankind can live in harmony, tranquility,

and disciplined. Islam established has principles that are profound and firm, such as the ones mentioned in verse 6 of soorah al-Kaafiroon:

"For you is your religion, and for me is my religion."

In addition, there are Islamic principles that are universal in nature, such as mutual aiding in matters regarding virtue and service, prioritizing lofty adab (etiquette), humanity, upholding

justice, and performing good deeds.

As Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala mentions in verse 90 of soorah an-Nahl:

"Indeed, Allah orders justice and good conduct and giving to relatives and forbids immorality and bad conduct and oppression. He admonishes you that perhaps you will be reminded."

To end the khutbah, let us altogether reflect and derive lessons as follows:

1. The Muslim ummah must know that mankind is born from various background for the purpose of getting to know one another, and complementing each other.

2. The Muslim ummah must remain responsible in ensuring that unity, harmony, and stability within the nation remain strong, according to pure Islamic authentic principles.

3. The Muslim ummah must jamaa 'ah remain in (congregation) performing 'ibaadah (acts of worship) unto Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala, so as to attain unity and cooperation based on Islam and imaan that is one.

"And, [moreover], this is My path, which is straight, so follow it; and do not follow [other] ways, for you will be separated from His way. This has He instructed you that you may become righteous." (al-An'aam 6:153)

THE SECOND KHUTBAH

O Allah! We seek refuge in You from severe trials, from being afflicted with calamities, from evil in destiny, and from the joy of the enemies upon the tribulations and misfortunes

that befell us. O Allah! We beseech Your protection, from losing the favors that You have bestowed, from the loss of health that You have granted, protect us from calamity and disaster.

O Allah! You are our One and Only Savior, we humbly beg You to save Masjid al-Aqsa Palestine.

O Allah! Make us among Your slaves that fulfills the amaanah. Strengthen our imaan so that we avoid treachery, protect us from becoming among those that neglect their responsibilities,

and protect our state and nation from destruction due to bribery. Render the duty to lead our country upon Your slaves whom are trustworthy and honest,

as well as firm and courageous in upholding the truth and executing justice according to the Sharee'ah. O Allah, make the masaajid and suraus in

the state of Selangor as Your peaceful homes, uniting everyone, and serve as the heart of the ummah's strength.
