On this blessed day, I will be discussing upon a *khutbah* titled "INTEGRITY AS THE CORE OF NATIONAL HARMONYA."

Blessed Friday audience,

Integrity is a very important core element in our lives. We always hear at various levels where the word "integrity" is mentioned. According to *Dewan Bahasa dan Pustaka* (DBP) dictionary, integrity is defined as: honesty, sincerity, perfection, and wholeness. This means that integrity is a personality trait that includes sincerity, openness, transparency, trustworthy, truthfulness, holding onto principles, not easily influenced, reliable, able to keep one's word, and others.

Integrity is from among the important values, and it holds a major role in developing human behavior and personality in forming perfection within oneself. Praiseworthy values, namely *mahmoodah* traits, manifests norms and utmost standards of conduct in the lives of an individual. The value of integrity is not just in transforming the landscape and ecosystem of life within the members of society, but it also aids the nation in achieving its goals as well as success that has been designed so that Malaysia will be known for its integrity, not bribery.

Rasulullah is the best exemplary as the servant of Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala possessing utmost integrity that he was widely known with title 'al-Ameen' which means 'one who is very trustworthy'. Four personal values and commendable traits found in Rasulullah that became the core for the values of integrity are as-Siddeeq (truthful), Amaanah (trustworthy), Tabligh (advocacy), and Fatanah (wisdom).

Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala mentions in verse 21 of Soorah al-Ahzaab:



"There has certainly been for you in the Messenger of Allah an excellent pattern for anyone whose hope is in Allah and the Last Day and [who] remembers Allah often."

This verse encourages us to emulate Rasulullah in all matters, specifically the traits of *amaanah* and honesty. Hence, attaining tremendous reward and lofty stature in the Sight of Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala*. On the contrary, not having integrity such as untrustworthy, dishonest, and constantly engulfed with traits of *mazhmoomah* (blameworthy) within oneself, it will adversely affect one's rank in the Sight of Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala*. Furthermore, he or she will be afflicted with calamity in this world and the Hereafter.

Beloved Friday congregants,

The benefits or advantages of having integrity will not only be attained by that Muslim individual alone, but also the family members, the society, and the nation. This is because life becomes more harmonious when society has high integrity by always being honest in speech and trust given.

This reminder coincides with the explanation in the *hadeeth* of 'Abdullah bin Mas'ood *radiyAllaahu 'anh* whom reported that Rasulullah said:

A man continues tell lies and encourages falsehood until he is recorded with Allah as a liar."

Respected audience,

Malaysia is a multicultural nation. This can be seen in the diversity of ethnicity, culture, and faith, which make this country truly unique. Although inhabited by a variety of races, ethnicity, culture and creed, we can all live in a harmonious and peaceful environment, resulting from mutual respect, loving one another, togetherness, and the spirit of unity in defending the country's sovereignty.

However, sometimes we are tested with various issues that can threaten our unity due to the actions by those without integrity and irresponsible by injecting elements of discord and enmity through social media.

Take heed that the well-being and prosperity of the country is also an amaanah (trust) from Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala that must be safeguarded. We are often exposed to various evil within society that are related to the collapse of integrity values. Realize that those who do not uphold integrity values, honesty, and trustworthiness will cause themselves



to plunge into wickedness such as bribery, *khiyaanah* (betrayal), deceit, and breach of trust, which can surely destroy organizations, societal institutions, and nations.

Accordingly, with the internalization and practice of authentic Islamic teachings, honesty and trustworthiness can be instilled and planted within us, further educating the family and children to begin practicing values of integrity from home. In conjunction with National Integrity Month Celebration 2024 throughout the month of November, and the 20th anniversary of the Malaysian Institute of Integrity (IIM), IIM has organized various awareness programs, as well as intensifying and empowering the culture of integrity within all sectors, namely the public, private, and community, so as to increase the values and ethics of integrity.

Dear beloved Friday audience,

To end the *khutbah* today, let us derive several lessons as guidance in our lives, namely:

- 1. The Muslim *ummah* must practice Islamic teachings with perfection, increasing the *imaan* (belief), and develop *ihsaan* (excellence) within, in building a high level of integrity.
- 2. The Muslim *ummah* must nurture the traits of *amaanah*, honesty, *ikhlaas* (sincerity), truthfulness, and responsibility, as well as ridding off negative traits such as betrayal, opportunistic, and fraudulent.
- 3. The Muslim *ummah* must educate members of the household and the children in practicing integrity values from home, in grooming a society possessing utmost integrity.
- 4. Any individuals that do not prioritize integrity within themselves will be prone to committing sinful acts that will only anger Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala*.
